GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, is available online at www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm and is hereby made part of the agreement. - 14. CONFIDENTIALITY: The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures, and rules. - 15. LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, and the West Virginia Insurance Commission. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
- 16. ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

Alternates offered by the bidder as EQUAL to the specifications must be clearly defined. A bidder offering an alternate should attach complete specifications and literature to the bid. The Purchasing Division may waive minor deviations to specifications.
- 3. Unit prices shall prevail in case of discrepancy. All quotations are considered F.O.B. destination unless alternate shipping terms are clearly identified in the quotation.
- 4. All quotations must be delivered by the bidder to the office listed below prior to the date and time of the bid opening. Question #1 - Must have all tires filled with Polyfil: (Will Rimgard suffice?)

Answer #1 – NO. Rimguard (<u>www.rimguard.biz</u>) is a liquid fill tire ballast which will leak out, like calcium and alcohol fillers, and permit flats if a tire is punctured. Polyfil, i.e. Tyrfil G2 manufactured by Pathway Polymers (<u>www.pathwaypolymers.com</u>) is a polyurethane compound that is injected into a tire to provide ballast and replace liquids and air in the tire, making the tire impervious to flats from punctures or vandalism. Tyrfil is used in construction and skidder tires to prevent flats.

Since this tractor will be used in remote country populated with hawthorne and locust thorns, Polyfil, i.e. Tyrfil, was specified to be used as tire ballast to prevent flats and consequent tire repairs in areas where it would be impossible for tire repair technicians and equipment to access. Repair/transport of ballasted tractor tires is beyond the capability of DNR field personnel.

Question #2 - Must have a digging depth of at least 8': (Our manufacture provides a model with 7'8" of digging depth and one with 9'4" ONLY):

Answer #2 – NO. 9'4" backhoe digging depth would be acceptable, provided that it will perform within the specifications of the tractor.

Question #3 - Must have bolt-on shanks with pin-on teeth: (Our manufacture provides weld-onshanks with pin-on teeth)

Answer #3-NO. Bolt on shanks and pin on teeth were specified for the same reasons Polyfil was specified in the tractor tires, i.e. field repairs in remote country without access to welders or other specialized equipment.
