# GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, is available online at www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm and is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 14. CONFIDENTIALITY: The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures, and rules. - 15. LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, and the West Virginia Insurance Commission. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
- 16. ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

#### 2011 Freightliner M2 106 or equal

### Truck must meet the following specifications:

- New conventional cab truck with a minimum GVWR of 38,000 pounds
- · Wheel base: 170 inches
- Minimum 80,000psi yield strength steel frame, reinforcement of 50/80,000 frame
- Engine: Turbo charged diesel with a minimum of 300 horsepower and a minimum 860 ft lb. of torque. Also must have an engine compression brake (not exhaust)
- Transmission: Eaton Fuller 10-speed manual with provisions for power takeoff or equal. Control pad to be dash mounted.
- Front Axle: Minimum 12,000 pound capacity with a minimum of 12,000 pound capacity leaf springs and heavy duty shocks.

   CFM. Must also have air dryer and moisture ejector systems. Dust shields on rear brakes.
   Automatic slack adjusters on front and rear brakes. Automatic limiting valves on front brakes.
- Batteries: Dual 12 volt with a minimum 1,850 CCA
- Alternator: 12 volt with a minimum of 160 amp output
- Wheels: Steel, 22.5 x 8.25 front and rear
- Tires: Front: Minimum 12R22.5 G (14 ply) radial tubeless highway tread

## **Bed Specs:**

- Steel platform type with a minimum 15-ton single cylinder hydraulic scissor hoist.
- Air shift PTO control to be mounted on dash of cab.
- Hoist pump control lever cable type not acceptable, to be mounted in an easily accessible location to the outside rear of cab on driver's side.
- Platform is to be 13 feet long by 8 feet wide, constructed of 3/16 smooth steel to be welded to bed sills. Cross members shall extend to and be welded to side rails except where cross member may interfere with wheel clearance. Bed cross members to be 4" x 1/5", 11 gauge steel channel on 12 inch centers and welded to bed sills. Front and rear cross members and every one in between to be braced to bed sill with 1/4" steel plates, triangular in shape with 6" edges. One edge of plate to be welded to sill and the other edge welded to underside of cross member to extend 6" toward outside of bed.
- Side rails and ends to be 6" high and to be 12 gauge metal. Bed sills to be 7" construction channel, sufficient height to allow enough clearance for the use of tire chains on a fully loaded truck.
- Bed to be mounted 8" from rear of cab. Bed to have clearance and marker lights and mud flaps that comply with WV state law.

Note: Manufacturer's standard warranty and service policy to be included and shall be honored by all the manufacturer's authorized dealers.

# **PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT**

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owned is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, Limited Liability Company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

**EXCEPTION:** The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (West Virginia Code §61-5-3), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.
