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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.

The West Virginia State Police is requesting an open end contract for laboratory procedures during In-Service Training for active members, as well as recruits. This testing would take place at the West Virginia State Police Academy located at Dunbar WV. All procedures will take place at the Academy with no subcontracts.

Tests to be conducted are as follows:

RPR-Rapid Plasma Reagin (Select Group)
CBC — Complete Blood Count
Comprehensive Metabolic Panel
Lipid Panel
GCT
Uric Acid
UA-Urinalysis
PSA-Prostate Specific Antigen (Select Group)
ANTI-HBSAG — (Select Group)

There will be approximately 35 people per visit for each annual In-Service training session. This will occur once a week from the first week of February through the first week of June. The total number will not exceed 550 per calendar year for In-Service training sessions.

Approximately 100 people per year will be tested for WV State Police applicants. This testing may occur at any time during a 12 month calendar year, however will not occur more than 4 days per year.

A Phlebotomist will be provided by the vendor to travel to the WV State police Academy to obtain specimens. Said Phlebotomist will be responsible for transporting the specimens to the vendor for testing. Any travel cost incurred for this will be the responsibility of the vendor.

The vendor will provide all specimen collection equipment which shall include, but not limited to blood collection tubes, urine specimen containers, needles, alcohol swabs, 2X2X etc.

In addition to the aforementioned testing procedure, a narcotic drug screen will be performed on the State Police applicants only. This will include testing for the following drugs:

BARBITURATES, URATES, COCAINE, METHODONE, OPIATES, PCP, AMPHETAMINES, MARIJUANA AND VALIUM.

These specimens will be ready for pickup by the vendor to be transported to the vendor's facility by 8:00 a.m. and reports for all lab tests will be provided to the WV State Police Medical Unit within 24 hours by the most expedient means possible (fax, courier etc..)

REPORTING

Industry Standard Laboratory test will be completed by 3:00 p.m. on the same day lab specimens is obtained during In-Service Training. The test results then will be provided to the State Police Medical Unit by the most expedient means possible (fax, courier etc..)

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

"Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
