The Acquisition and Contract Administration Section of the Purchasing Division "State" for the West Virginia General Services Division is soliciting quotations for all labor, materials and associated costs to provide plaster repair, finishing, molding fabrication and installation services in selected areas of Attorney General Suite of the Main Unit of the Capitol Building on the State Capitol Complex. This document is intended to supplement information provided in the standard "Request for Quotation" and "General Terms and Conditions" issued by the Purchasing Division for this project. Vendors should carefully review all documents.

Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting:

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on Monday, September 27, 2010, at 10:00am. Contractors attending the meeting shall assemble at Room MB-60 in the Capitol Building basement. See Purchasing Division Request for Quotation for additional information.

State of West Virginia General Services Division

I. Scope of Work:

The work consists of plaster fabrication along the ceiling of the common hall to replicate the original design at a lower ceiling being constructed (by GSD). The crown molding will be installed on the (long) North and south walls approximately 72 ft on each side to reach adjoining wall trim and an 8ft end wall. Contractor will paint in like manner as walls with GSD-furnished paint (ceiling-White), Contractor is responsible for all aspects of fabrication and installation of plaster on recently installed hall ceiling wall board due to renovations as required and application of GSD-furnished paint (two finish coats). Contractor will perform required patching of all wall penetrations and ceiling penetrations made during renovations or which have previously existed. Primer and all other miscellaneous supplies and material will be furnished by contractor, including tools, equipment and scaffolding. Square footage of ceiling space is approximately 1804 square feet. (All measurements are subject to and the responsibility of contractor to field verify)

The successful contractor shall be required to keep the work area clean on a DAILY basis and remove debris from the site daily. All applicable local safety and OSHA rules / guidelines shall be met by the contractor.

This work will be performed in accordance with acceptable industry standards for work of this type. Payment of prevailing wage rates in Kanawha County as listed by The State Department of Labor is a requirement for this project.

Any equipment contracted for prior to receipt of the signed purchase order and written Notice to Proceed letter shall be at the Bidder's risk.

II. GENERAL CONDITIONS

A. The qualified Contractor will perform work for the satisfactory plaster repair and painting of the offices described herein. Authorization to perform the work described herein must be approved in writing and signed by the Owners Representative or Designee.

- B. The successful bidder will perform the work described herein and be responsible for all necessary permits, fees and related items to fulfill the contract.
- C. Two copies (one original and one copy) of invoices will be submitted for payment (in arrears) and must include the following information:
 - 1. Invoice must include FEIN number, complete address of vendor, Owner work order number, and purchase order number of the contract.
 - 2. Invoices will be mailed to the following address:

D. The relationship of the Contractor to the Owner shall be that of an independent contractor and no principal-agent relationship or employer-employee relationship is contemplated or created by the parties to this Contract. The Contractor as an independent contractor is solely liable for the acts and omissions of its employees and agents. The Contractor will be responsible for selecting, supervising, and compensating any and all individuals employed pursuant to the terms of this contract. Neither the Contractor nor any employees or sub-contractors of the Contractor will be deemed to be employees for the State for any purposes whatsoever. The wages and salaries, taxes, withholding payments, penalties, fees, fringe benefits, professional liability insurance premiums, contributions to insurance and pension or other deferred obligations, and licensing fees, etc., and the filing of all necessary documents, forms and returns pertinent to all of the foregoing are the Contractor's responsibility.

The Contractor will hold harmless the State, and must provide the State and Agency with a defense against any and all claims including but not limited to the foregoing payments, withholdings, contributions, taxes, social security taxes and employer income tax returns. The Contractor will not assign, convey, transfer, sub-contract, or delegate any of its responsibilities and obligations under this contract to any person, corporation, partnership, association or entity without expressed written consent of the Agency.

E. Indemnification: The Contractor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the State and the Owner, their officers, and employees from and against (1) Any claims or losses for services rendered by any subcontractor, person or firm performing or

supplying services, materials, or supplies in connection with the performance of the Contract; (2) Any claims or losses resulting to any person or entity injured or damaged by the Contractor, its officers, employees, or subcontractors by the publication, translation, reproduction, delivery, performance, use, or disposition of any data used under the Contract in a manner not authorized by the Contract, or by Federal or State statutes or regulations; (3) Any failure of the Contractor, its officers, employees or sub-contractors to observe State and Federal laws, including but not limited to labor and wage laws.

- F. This contract will be governed by the laws of the State of West Virginia. The Contractor further agrees to comply with the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all other applicable Federal, State, and local Government regulations.
- G. The Contractor will procure all necessary permits and licenses to comply with all applicable laws, Federal, State, or municipal, along with all regulations, and ordinances of any regulating body.
- H. The Contractor will pay any applicable sales, use, or personal property taxes arising out of this contract and the transactions contemplated thereby. Any other taxes levied upon this Contract, the transaction, or the equipment, or services delivered pursuant hereto shall be borne by the Contractor.  - a. Contractor will be responsible for all mileage and travel costs, including travel time, associated with the performance of this contract.
 - b. By submittal of your bid you will include a warranty for a minimum of one (1) year for labor and a minimum of one (1) years for materials. Other than GSD-furnished paint, the Contractor will be responsible for all other materials used to complete the project.
 - c. Contractor will have forty-five (45) calendar days from the issuance of a Notice to Proceed to complete the work described in this contract. Time is of the essence on this project, and the work

will need coordinated in detail with the Agency to minimize tenant inconveniences.

- J. Any and all work to be performed to successfully execute the terms of this Contract by a third party or sub-contractor must be pre-approved by the Owner or their Representative or Designee. The minimum amount of commercial general liability insurance coverage required is \$1,000,000.00, and a copy of contractor certificate of insurance is required prior to issuance of purchase order for this agreement.

Bonds and Insurance:

Refer to Purchasing Division's 'Request for Quotation' for requirements on bonding; insurance; wage rates; "Foreign made aluminum, glass and steel in Public Works Projects", and other project requirements.

It is strongly preferred that the successful bidder provide all necessary Labor & Materials and Performance Bonds, any required Insurance Certificates, and other required documentation within Seventy-Two (72) hours of notice of award of Contract.

Final Inspection:

The Final Inspection will be conducted by a Project Manager from the General Services Division, Operations and Maintenance Section

Work found to be in accordance with the Contract Documents will be accepted as complete for final acceptance. Unacceptable work, or work not in accordance with the Contract Documents shall be removed, replaced, changed or cleaned as required to meet requirements of Contract Documents prior to final acceptance. Work Restrictions:

Parking

No parking is available on the project site. Parking in non-designated areas is not permitted. A limited number of spaces will be allocated for contractors vehicles near the project site. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
