**Specific Qualification Criteria:** Perkin Elmer is the only company that provides the NeoBase Non-derivatized MSMS reagent kit. There is no other source of dried blood spot NeoBase controls, Amino Acids Internal standards or Acylcarnitines Internal standards that are FDA cleared for Newborn Screening.
