GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the selfer.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BAA), approved by the Attorney General, is available online at www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.htm and is hereby made part of the agreement. Provided that the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 14. CONFIDENTIALITY: The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures, and rules. Vendor further agrees to comply with the Confidentiality Policies and Information Security Accountability Requirements, set forth in http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/privacy/noticeConfidentiality.pdf.
- 15. LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, and the West Virginia Insurance Commission. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
- 16. ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.



The West Virginia Lottery, an agency of the West Virginia Department of Revenue, is seeking quotations from qualified certified public accounting firms for financial review analysis and advice concerning video lottery terminal manufacturers, licensed racetracks and licensed operators, table games supply manufacturers or persons applying for licenses for these licenses or permits under the Racetrack Video Lottery Act [W.Va. Code §29-22A-1 et seq.], the Limited Video Lottery Act [W.Va. Code §29-22B-1 et seq.], the Racetrack Table Games Act [W.Va. Code §29-22C-1 et seq.], the Limited Gaming Facility [Casino] Act [W.Va. Code §29-25-1] and/or other Acts that may be enacted prior to or during the term of the contract issued pursuant to their RFQ. The State Lottery Commission requires a consultant accounting firm that is able to provide calculations and analysis, and to give the Commission candid and unbiased advice, concerning the initial licensing and continuing re-licensing processes as well as intermediate financial transactions requiring the prior approval of the Commission. The accounting firm will provide management consulting services and will perform special reviews and/or analysis of administration of the Lottery's responsibilities under WV Code §29-22-29.

Scope of Services

The firm awarded the contract as a result of this RFQ will assist the Director of the West Virginia Lottery and the seven-member Commission to review the financial condition of businesses licensed, permitted, or applying for licenses or permits as video lottery terminal manufacturers, licensed racetracks, limited video lottery licensed operators and table games supply manufacturers under the Racetrack Video Lottery Act [W.Va. Code §29-22A-1 et seq.], the Limited Video Lottery Act [W.Va. Code §29-22B-1 et seq.], the Racetrack Table Games Act

[W.Va. Code §29-22C-1 et seq.], the Limited Gaming Facility [Casino] Act [W.Va. Code §29-25-1] and/or by other Acts that may be enacted prior to or during the term of the contract issued pursuant to this RFQ. The accounting firm will provide management consulting services and will perform special reviews and/or analysis of administration of the Lottery's responsibilities under WV Code §29-22-29.

Services will include, but are not limited to, the review of year-end financial statements, (both audited and unaudited) of applicants. The review of applicants interim financial statements, business plan, financial projections, Federal and State tax returns as well as, when applicable, their filings with the SEC. Such services will also include the review of proposed and final loan documents. In addition, a review may be required of the personal financial statements of certain shareholders, officers and members of their board of directors (or other group depending upon the business structure of the applicant) of the applicant as well as a review of personal federal and state income tax returns.

From time to time, the Commission will meet in other parts of West Virginia, usually at a racetrack location, and the firm will be expected to attend most of these meetings to present analysis at public meetings.

Bid Amount

The amount of the bid submitted by each potential vendor shall be a fixed hourly rate for services rendered. This rate shall be the same regardless of which partner or member performs the services and shall be sufficient to cover any and all incidental expenses including but by no means limited to copy or computer research costs. Out of pocket travel expenses shall be billed in accordance with the State of West Virginia's Travel Rules as prescribed by the Travel Management Unit, Purchasing Division.

Expenses Incurred

The State of West Virginia and the West Virginia Lottery will not be liable for any expenses incurred by any Vendor in the preparation and submission of quotations for this RFQ

Termination/Cancellation of this RFQ

The Purchasing Division reserves the right to modify, withdraw, and/or cancel this RFQ at any time, even after the submission of responding quotations, if such withdrawal is to the benefit of the State of West Virginia or the West Virginia State Lottery. If this RFQ is withdrawn, no contract awards will be made pursuant to this RFQ.

Assignment

The relationship of the selected firm to the State of West Virginia, and to the West Virginia Lottery, will be that of an independent contractor, with no principal-agent or employer-employee relationships created by the parties to any resultant agreement. The firm shall not assign, convey, transfer, or delegate any of its responsibilities or obligations under the resultant agreement without prior written approval of the State Lottery Commission. Such approval may be granted by the sole discretion of the State Lottery Commission. No assignments, if any are granted, shall release the vendor from its liability for the prompt and effective performance of the obligations hereunder.

Governing Law

The contract resulting from this RFQ will be governed by the laws of the State of West Virginia. The State of West Virginia asserts its Eleventh Amendment right not to be sued in any federal court.

Taxes

The State of West Virginia, and the West Virginia Lottery, are exempt from Federal Excise taxes, and from State and local sales and use taxes, on the services to be supplied as a result of any contracts resulting from this RFQ. Consequently, the State of West Virginia and the West Virginia Lottery will have no responsibilities for the payment of any taxes that become payable by the successful firm.

Acceptance Period for Quotations

The quotations submitted in response to this RFQ shall remain fixed and valid for a period of six (6) months commencing on the date the quotations are due.

Firm Information

Responding firms should include the following information with their bid proposal submittal. The WV Lottery reserves the right to request this or any additional information at any time during the bid evaluation process prior to their recommendation of award notification to the West Virginia Purchasing Division.

- (a) Name and address of the firm submitting the quotation along with the federal employer identification number of the vendor.
- (b) Date of registration to do business in the State of West Virginia. Foreign corporations and businesses do not need to register to do business in West Virginia to submit a quotation, but must do so before a contract can be issued.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (*West Virginia Code* §61-5-3), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.
