Detailed Description of Project: Provide a study on the economic impact of the five in-state casinos and related operations, excluding their racing operations. This study is to document the economic impacts (direct, indirect and induced, and total) associated with the operation of the five casinos during fiscal year 2010 (July 1, 2009-June 30, 2010). The impacts will be based upon financial information provided by the five casinos, and will be estimated using the IMPLAN® Modeling System or equivalent. Estimated impacts will include employment, employee compensation, business volume, value added and output. In addition, the study will provide estimates of assorted state taxes (corporate net income, business franchise, sales tax, personal income tax, among others) associated with the total economic impacts.
