1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.

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Specifications

Purpose: To clear and mulch trees and shrubs, spray stumps to prevent growth and install traffic control devices on Bluestone Lake Road in Summers County

1.0 DEFINITIONS

- A. The "Agency" shall be defined as the West Virginia Division of Highways
- B. The "Vendor" shall be defined as the successful bidder.
- C. The "Purchase Order" shall be defined as the binding agreement that is entered into between the State of West Virginia and the Vendor to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Mandatory Requirements: The terms "must", "will", "shall", "minimum", "maximum", or "is/are required" identify a mandatory item or factor. Decisions regarding compliance with any mandatory requirements shall be at the sole discretion of the State.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The successful Vendor shall provide traffic control, clearing and grubbing and spray with a growth inhibitor or cut-surface treatment

2.1 Technical Requirements:

Traffic control – Case A3 of the 2006 Edition of the Manual on Temporary Traffic Control for Streets and Highways will be used for this project. Traffic control will comply with the Standard Specifications for Section 636 Maintaining Traffic. The website for the Temporary Traffic Control manual is:

Clearing and Grubbing – Clearing will be used to remove all trees and shrubs within the eight designated working sites for this project. All tree litter, limbs, branches, and shrubs will be cut/mulched to no higher than 18 inches above the ground surface. Tree stumps will be cut to the height described under sub-section 201.4 of the specifications meaning all trees,

shrubs, and brush shall be cutoff to leave a stump which does not protrude out of the existing ground more than 6 inches.

Growth inhibitor – All tree stumps are to be sprayed with a growth inhibitor or cut-surface treatment after the tree or shrub has been cut. This work will be incidental to item 201001-000, Clearing and Grubbing. The contractor must be licensed in the state of West Virginia to apply pesticides (growth inhibiting chemicals). A copy of the vendors applicator license shall be required prior to award. The only chemicals approved for use are the following: Picloram 5.4% with 2,4-D 20.9%, Triclopyr 44.4% or Picloram 10.2% with 2,4-D 39.6%.

GOVERNING SPECIFICATIONS: The West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways, Standard Specifications, Roads and Bridges, adopted 2010 and the West Virginia Department of Transportation, Division of Highways Supplemental Specification dated January 1, 2012. The Contract Documents and the Contract Plans are the governing provisions applicable to this project.

PLAN: Plan sheets numbered with a PL-prefix in this proposal are considered as plan sheets for purposes of administering Section 105.4 of the Specifications concerning coordination of contract documents.

NOTES:

Department personnel will mark the beginning and ending points of the work to be performed.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: Case A3 of the 2006 Edition of the "Manual on Temporary Traffic Control for Streets and Highways" will be used for this project. The Manual may be viewed at http://www.transportation.wv.gov/highways/engineering/Manuals/Traffic/TCM_06L.pdf. Traffic control will comply with the Standard Specifications for Section 636 "Maintaining Traffic" to provide safety for the workers and the traveling public.

UTILITIES

It is the Contractors' responsibility to contact MISS UTILITY OF WEST VIRGINIA INCORPORATED (Ph. *1-800-245-4848) at least 48 hours prior to any subsurface disturbance, i.e. drilling, unclassified excavation, etc. The Contractor is responsible for verifying the locations of all existing utilities and notifying any utility within the limits of the project of all work to be performed. Utility companies will normally locate and mark their existing facilities on the ground within three (3) working days. The Engineer will make every effort to adjust the proposed installations to avoid conflicts with or relocations by the utility. If utility relocations are required, they will be given at least ten (10) days to start and/or finish their work.

CLEARING AND GRUBBING

Clearing, sub-section 201.4 of the specifications, will be used to remove all trees and shrubs within the eight designated working sites for this project except for trees designated by the Engineer to remain. All tree litter, limbs, branches, and shrubs, will be cut/mulched to no higher than 18 inches above the ground surface. Tree stumps will be cut to the height(s) described under sub-section 201.4 of the specifications meaning all trees, shrubs, and brush shall be cutoff to leave a stump which does not protrude out of the existing ground more than six inches (6"). Grubbing, sub-section 201.6 of the specifications, will not be performed for any of the eight sites of this project, and no ground disturbing activities are anticipated to occur for this project. All other sub-sections of Section 201, Clearing and Grubbing, are to be followed as detailed within the Standard Specifications.

GROWTH INHIBITOR (CUT-SURFACE TREATMENT)

All tree stumps are to be sprayed with a growth inhibitor or cut-surface treatment after the tree or shrub has been cut. The stumps shall be treated with an approved growth inhibitor within 48 hours of the tree or shrub being cut. This work will be incidental to Item 201001-000, Clearing and Grubbing. The contractor must be licensed in the state of West Virginia to apply pesticides (growth inhibiting chemicals). The only chemicals approved for use are the following:

Picloram 5.4% with 2,4-D 20.9% (the approximate ingredients in Tordon RTU) or

Triclopyr 44.4% (the approximate ingredients in Gorton 3A) or

Picloram 10.2% with 2,4-D 39.6% (the approximate ingredients in Tordon 101)

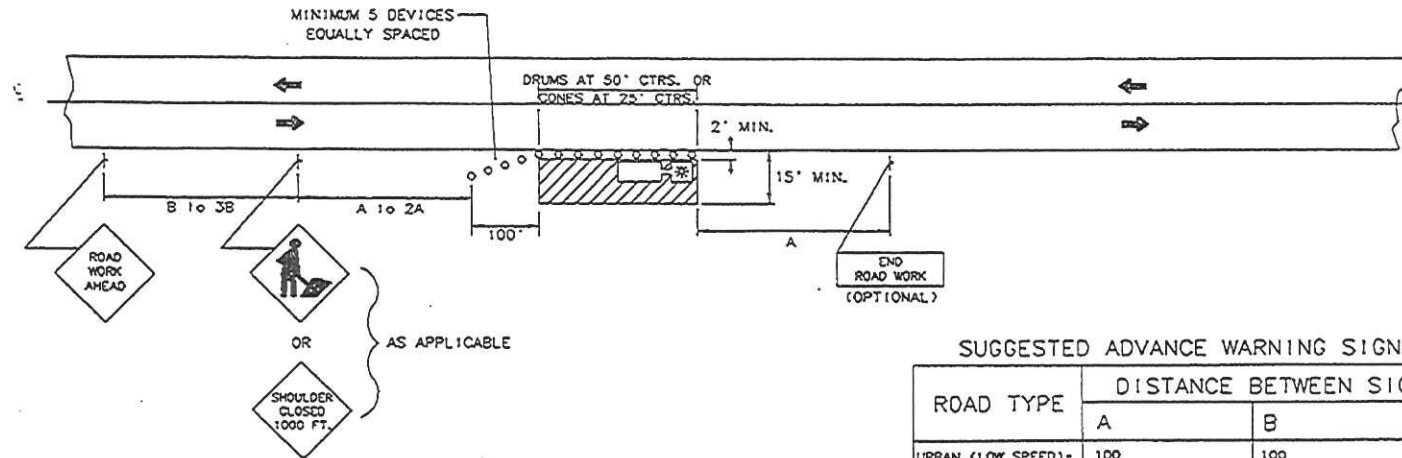
The WV Division of Highways and Corps of Engineers do not recommend the brand name products over any similar product produced by competing brand or generic manufacturers. The specimen label for any product chosen must be strictly adhered to at all times. Treatment must not exceed that as approved by law. Surface and ground water must be protected at all times. Gorton 4 is NOT approved. Broadcast cut stump treatment is NOT allowed, and each stump must be treated individually.

PRE-BID MEETING

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held for this project. Any contractor wishing to bid on this contract MUST be at this meeting.

PESTICIDE LICENSE

A copy of the vendor's applicator license must be provided to the West Virginia Division of Highways prior to awarding the contract. The vendor is required to have a Category 7 pesticide license. The vendor must provide the applicator name, class, category, and license number with his or her bid.

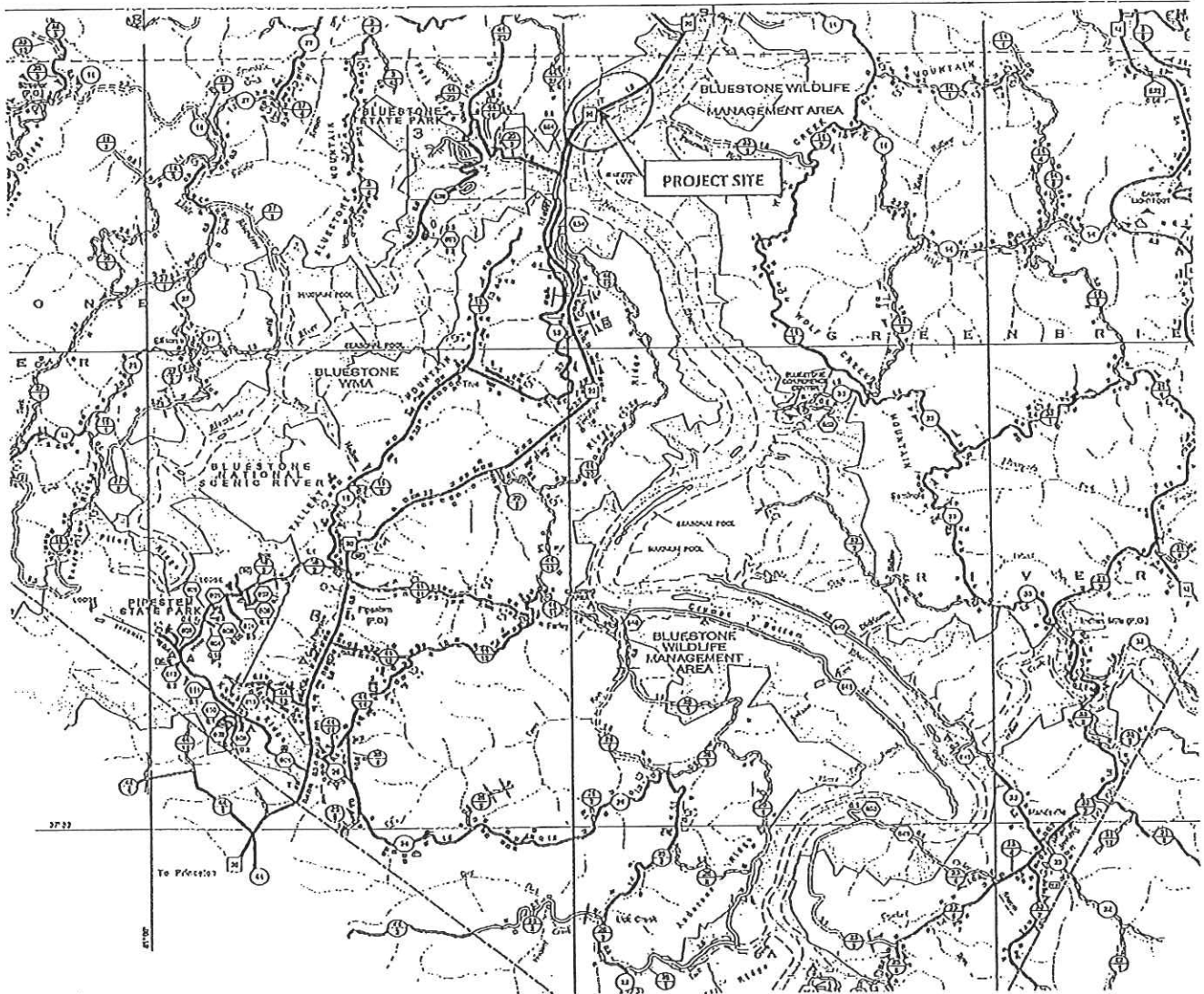

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (*West Virginia Code §61-5-3*), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.
