GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
12. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

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Request for Quotation Specifications

Purpose: The WVDOH maintains Contracts for frangible breakaway hardware for use with the u-channel post systems known to currently be in service along WVDOH highways. The purpose of this contract is to establish an open end contract to provide the West Virginia Division of Highways with frangible breakaway hardware to be used for Franklin Industries u-channel ground splices.

1.0 DEFINITIONS

- A. The "Agency" shall be defined as the West Virginia Division of Highways
- B. The "Vendor" shall be defined as the successful bidder.
- C. The "Contract" shall be defined as the binding agreement that is entered into between the State of West Virginia and the Vendor to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Release Order" shall be defined as order placed against the Contract by the Agency.
- E. Mandatory Requirements: The terms "must", "will", "shall", "minimum", "maximum", or "is/are required" identify a mandatory item or factor. Decisions regarding compliance with any mandatory requirements shall be at the sole discretion of the State.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The successful Vendor shall provide frangible breakaway hardware to be used for Franklin Industries u-channel ground splices per the specifications herein.

2.1 Technical Requirements:

2.1.1: Contract Items:

Item #1 shall be 1 ea. Franklin Industries Base-Bolted u-channel breakaway system spacer.

Item #2 shall consist of 1 ea. Franklin Industries Base-Bolted u-channel breakaway system lock washer, flat washer, Grade 9 bolt, and hex nut.

2.1.2 SUBSTITUTIONS FOR ITEMS DESCRIBED UNDER 2.1.1

The Vendor may propose to supply a substitute frangible splicing system for the Franklin Industries manufactured hardware, as described in 2.1.1 and 2.1.2. Substitute hardware shall be approved by the FHWA as meeting the requirements of NCHRP-350 and / or AASHTO-MASH for splicing Franklin Industries 2# and 3# u-channel. The substitute system shall be approved for assemblies with three (3) supports within a seven (7) foot width. The maximum splice length shall be equal or less than that required for the Franklin Industries Base-Bolted system.

If a vendor proposes to supply substitute hardware meeting the requirements describe above, the vendor shall submit adequate specifications, approvals, and additional information determined to be necessary by the WVDOH demonstrating that the above requirements are met. By submitting a bid on these items, it is understood that the Vendor also certifies that the devices and components that they are supplying do not violate any proprietary patents.

Approval of the substitute devices and components proposed by the Vendor must be obtained in writing from the WVDOH prior to the letting date of this Contract.

2.2 Freight

2.2.1 All shipments are to be FOB Destination.

2.2.2 The Vendor shall be responsible for all freight charges incurred as a result of the purchases under this Contract.

2.3 Delivery

2.3.1 The attached list of delivery addresses represents the address of each District Sign Shop. The WVDOH reserves the right to specify additional delivery addresses in each District other than those listed.

2.3.2 Release Orders shall be delivered in full within a maximum of thirty (30) Calendar Days ARO. If the vendor is unable to deliver in full within thirty (30) Calendar Days, the Vendor shall be subject to a daily (per Calendar Day) penalty at the purchasing organizations discretion for each Calendar Day beyond thirty (30) Calendar Days ARO, until the order is received in full. This penalty shall be assessed by subtracting the penalty from the payment due to the Vendor upon full delivery of the Release Order. The penalty shall not exceed the original total amount of the Release Order. The penalty shall be calculated based on the Table shown at the following address:

The original total amount of the Release Order shall be substituted for the "Original Contract Amount" when using this Table.

2.3.3 Notification of shipment from Vendor shall be received a minimum of 24 hours (1 working day) prior to delivery of material at the delivery location indicated on the Release Order.

2.3.4 Delivery is an integral part of this contract and failure to comply will be cause to initiate a WV-82, Vendor Performance Form. This form will officially notify the West Virginia Division of Purchasing and the Vendor of unsatisfactory performance in the execution of this contract and the requirements herein.

3.0 ORDERING AND INVOICING

3.1 Release Orders

3.1.1 For all orders, the Agency will issue to the Vendor a WV-35 Release Order. Issuance of the Release Order shall contain the type of merchandise to be purchased and shall serve as the authorization to begin work.

3.1.2 There shall be no minimum order size associated with this contract. Release Orders must not be held by the Vendor until a maximum order point is reached.

3.2 Payment

3.2.1 The State of West Virginia currently utilizes a VISA purchasing card program which is issued through a local bank. The Vendor must accept the State of West Virginia purchasing card for payment of all orders placed against this Contract.

3.2.2 The Vendor must supply a credit card receipt, sales receipt, or cash register receipt. Charges must not be applied until merchandise is received by the Agency.

4.0 AWARD

4.1 Contract Sections

4.1.1 This Contract shall be awarded in its' entirety. The Vendor shall be required to provide a bid for all items listed.

- 1) The breakaway u-channel splice system supplied under this Contract is intended for use when a low-profile 4" lap splice is used and the post upright is post manufactured by Franklin Industries. The breakaway system supplied is approved by the FHWA as meeting NCHRP-350 and/or AASHTO-MASH. A FHWA approved breakaway system is required for 2# and 3# posts whenever there are three (3) posts in a seven (7) ft. width.
- 2) The Traffic Engineering Division has established a online form in order for District personnel to quickly and easily submit a documented report to the Traffic Engineering Division regarding any issues associated with any material orders. This form is intended to serve as a manner in which District personnel may quickly and easily submit a documented report to the Traffic Engineering Division regarding issues associated with the ordering, delivery and receipt of materials ordered off of Contracts established by Traffic Engineering, any quality issues with any of the materials received, and any issues associated with the reconciliation of orders. Also, note that this form may be used to report issues with the installation or performance of the materials once installed. The Traffic Engineering Division will work with the individual at the District submitting the report to obtain additional needed facts or documentation such as photos or product samples, and will contact and work with the Contract Vendor and Materials Division if needed in order to reconcile the issues in a manner acceptable to all parties if possible. Certification and application* is hereby made for Preference in accordance with West Virginia Code, §5A-3-37. (Does not apply to construction contracts). West Virginia Code, §5A-3-37, provides an opportunity for qualifying vendors to request (at the time of bid) preference for their residency status. Such preference is an evaluation method only and will be applied only to the cost bid in accordance with the West Virginia Code. This certificate for application is to be used to request such preference. The Purchasing Division will make the determination of the Resident Vendor Preference, if applicable.

By submission of this certificate, Bidder agrees to disclose any reasonably requested information to the Purchasing Division and authorizes the Department of Revenue to disclose to the Director of Purchasing appropriate information verifying that Bidder has paid the required business taxes, provided that such information does not contain the amounts of taxes paid nor any other information deemed by the Tax Commissioner to be confidential.

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owned is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, Limited Liability Company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceeds five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (*West Virginia Code §61-5-3*), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.
