GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
- 16. Human Resource Position

Description: To secure professional human resources consulting services contract for the West Virginia Military Authority for the period of one year with the option of two one-year renewals.

Background: The West Virginia Military Authority ("Authority") is a state agency created by the Legislature (See WV Code §15-1F et seq.) effective 1 July 2008. The agency is part of the Adjutant General's Office. The agency has approximately 400 employees. The employment positions and employees of the Authority are at-will and excluded by statute from the classified and the classified-exempt services. The administrative offices of the Authority are located at the Adjutant General's Office, 1703 Coonskin Drive, Charleston, WV 25311. The contractor shall report through the Chief Financial Officer, WV Military Authority.

Deliverables: Contractor shall provide the following professional human resources consulting services:

Develop, interpret, and apply agency personnel policies and procedures in accordance with all applicable Federal and State human resource statutes, regulations, policies and procedures and associated local regulations and ordinances necessary to support the agency, including:

- Operative definitions
- Job classification
- Employee recruitment, selection, and movement
- Conditions of employment
- Employee performance, appraisal, training & development
- Pay, holiday, and leave administration
- Employee conduct, discipline, separation, and grievance procedures

Provide Professional Job classifications services to:

- Support employment of new hires and movement of current employees as required
- Validate job descriptions for vacancy announcements and wage setting purposes

Plan Professional Compensation to include:

- Development of salary schedules and pay grade assignments for both current and future agency jobs
- Establish competitive hiring rates to support recruitment and retention of qualified employees
- Conduct Salary Surveys to support salary administration within the agency
- Prepare and/or review vacancy announcements for posting
- Develop and structure interview process for employee recruitment and selection
- Oversee and participate in selection interview panels
- Review applicants for ranking and selection

Develop and present training modules for agency managers and employees on human resource issues.

Consult with Adjutant General, Deputy Adjutant General, command staff, and Judge Advocate General about current issues, human resource policies and procedure.

Serve as liaison with the Governor's Office, Office of the Secretary of Military Affairs and Public Safety, and the WV Division of Personnel regarding human resource issues and individual personnel transactions

On-site Services: Contractor shall provide on-site consultation with Chief Financial Officer and agency staff at least three days per week and shall be available for immediate on-site consultation as the human resources activities of the agency require.

Contractor Qualifications: Contractor shall have the following **minimum** education and professional experience:

Education: Master's degree from an accredited four-year college or university in personnel administration, human resources, public administration, industrial organization or industrial psychology.

Experience: Seven years of paid professional State of West Virginia government human resources experience with a minimum of 2 years specific experience with military authority. The State government and National Guard military human resources employment shall include experience in the specific areas of:

- Development, interpretation and application of Military Authority personnel policies and procedures in accordance with Military Human Resource Management standard practices; inclusive of all the fore mentioned deliverables, as well as the specific strategies of personnel transformation, military human resource life cycle functions, and military occupational classification & structure systems.
- Professional job classification services to support the employment of new civilian hires and the movement of current employees as required; experience in translation of manpower requirements into specific skills and grade levels; validation of job descriptions for vacancy announcements and wage setting purposes in a large military based organization consisting of both enlisted and civilian personnel.
- Professional compensation planning to include the development of salary schedules and pay grade assignments for current jobs and those to be established in the future; the establishment of competitive hiring rates to support the recruitment and retention of qualified employees; and the conducting of salary surveys to support salary administration between enlisted and civilian personnel within the Military Authority.
- Professional employment services to include preparation and/or review of vacancy announcements for the posting of civilian personnel vacancies; the development of

- structured interview procedures for employee recruitment and selection including oversight of and participation in selection interview panels; reviewing of applications for applicant ranking and selection.
- Development and presentation of training modules for Military Authority managers and employees on human resources issues as necessary.

Professional Liability Insurance: Contractor shall have current professional liability insurance coverage of at least \$500,000 commensurate with the services being contracted for. A Certificate of Insurance naming the State of West Virginia as the certificate holder will be required prior to the issuance of any contract or purchase order.

Billing/documentation: Contractor shall present an invoice for services rendered by the 5th day of each month with all required documentation.

Fee/Hourly Rate: The vendor must bid an all-inclusive hourly rate for the deliverables specified herein. There will be no additional invoices considered by the agency for payment to the vendor for travel or any other incidentals required for the performance of the contract as advertised. The agency anticipates the contract to require between 15-20 hours of service per week.

The hourly rate quoted will be multiplied by 20 hrs for a weekly rate x 52 weeks for a maximum yearly contract amount. This maximum yearly contract amount cannot be exceeded without the issuance of an authorized change order from the Purchasing Division.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owned is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, Limited Liability Company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (West Virginia Code §61-5-3), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.
