GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.

3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division

and have paid the required \$125 fee.

- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
- 10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the Legislative Rules of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
- 11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
- 12. BANKRUPTCY: In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.
- 13. HIPAA BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM: The West Virginia State Government HIPAA Business Associate Addendum (BÁA), approved by the Attorney General, is available online at www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/vrc/hipaa.html and is hereby made part of the agreement provided that the Agency meets the definition of a Cover Entity (45 CFR §160.103) and will be disclosing Protected Health Information (45 CFR §160.103) to the vendor.
- 14. CONFIDENTIALITY: The vendor agrees that he or she will not disclose to anyone, directly or indirectly, any such personally identifiable information or other confidential information gained from the agency, unless the individual who is the subject of the information consents to the disclosure in writing or the disclosure is made pursuant to the agency's policies, procedures, and rules. Vendor further agrees to comply with the Confidentiality Policies and Information Security Accountability Requirements, set forth in http://www.state.wv.us/admin/purchase/privacy/noticeConfidentiality.pdf.
- 15. LICENSING: Vendors must be licensed and in good standing in accordance with any and all state and local laws and requirements by any state or local agency of West Virginia, including, but not limited to, the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office, the West Virginia Tax Department, and the West Virginia Insurance Commission. The vendor must provide all necessary releases to obtain information to enable the director or spending unit to verify that the vendor is licensed and in good standing with the above entities.
- 16. ANTITRUST: In submitting a bid to any agency for the State of West Virginia, the bidder offers and agrees that if the bid is accepted the bidder will convey, sell, assign or transfer to the State of West Virginia all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may now or hereafter acquire under the antitrust laws of the United States and the State of West Virginia for price fixing and/or unreasonable restraints of trade relating to the particular commodities or services purchased or acquired by the State of West Virginia. Such assignment shall be made and become effective at the time the purchasing agency tenders the initial payment to the bidder.

ADJ1205 Mountaineer Challenge Academy

The WV Adjutant General's Office – Mountaineer Challenge Academy is soliciting bids for athletic footwear and boots to be worn by cadets at the Academy.

Specifications for Boots:

Men's/ Women's 8" Ultra-Light Leather/Nylon Boots or equal. Bates # 2260 Men's, # 2700 Women's or equal. Boots must come at least in Men's size range 7 thru 12 Whole and 1/2 sizes Boots must come at least in Whole sizes 13 thru 15

Boots must come at least in Standard (D) and wide (E) at least thru size 14

Boots must be available in women's sizes (Bates style # 2700 or equal) at least size 2 thru size 6 with Standard (D) and Wide (E) Widths.

Boots must be EN ISO 20347 Certified

Boots must be Black in color

Boots must be constructed of the following or equal:

- a) Upper Material: Must be HH weight Full Grain Leather with Action leather and 1680 Denier Nylon or eqaul. The upper must be easy to clean and maintain. Break in time must be minimal.
- b) Upper Lining: The upper lining must be PK or equal mesh and breathable, durable and absorb perspiration.
- c) Lace: 60" Round Taslon lace or equal.
- d) Boxtoe: Must be 1.5mm Thermoplastic or equal to help retain shape of toe.
- e) Counter: Must be 1.85mm Thermoplastic or equal to help hold the heel to the back of the boot.
- f) Insole: Insole to be a non-woven strob material. This to provide flexibility and is light weight.
- g) Shank: Nylon shank or equal for instep support from heel to ball of foot.
- h) Midsole: Must be EVA midsole or equal that is lightweight and shock absorbing.
- i) Outsole: Must have aggressive profile styling for lateral stability, forefoot cross channels for flexibility and oval lugs for grip in all directions.
- j) Insole Insert: Must have removable insert made with EVA or equal. Must be soft breatheable and provide comfort and cushioning to the foot.

Specifications for athletic footwear:

New Balance 609 (MT609) or equal Must be a Cross-trainer (Designed to meet the requirements of many activities)

Must Come in Regular and 1/2 Size Sizes from 3 thru 13 Must Come in Whole Sizes at least 14 thru 18 Must come in Standard (D) Widths Must Come in at least Wide (2X) and Double Wide (4X) Widths Must be White in Color.

Must be constructed of or with the following or equal:

- a) Abzorb or equal cushioning in the heel for shock absorption.
- b) N-Durance or equal rubber compound for durability.
- c) At-Tread or equal all-terrain outsole combines a running and trail lug configuration for on and off road use.
- d) Stability shank embedded into midsole to support arch and create a smoother gate.
- e) IMEVA or equal midsole for firm but flexible cushioning.

Samples:

Vendor may be asked to provide sample shoes and boots that can be wear-tested for 30 days prior to the award. These samples will be sent to the Purchasing Division at the address listed below. The vendor will have (5) five business days to submit the samples, if requested by the Purchasing Division.

Award:

The contract will be awarded to the vendor or vendors with the lowest grand total meeting all of the specifications with the most complete bid. The State reserves the right to award each category (athletic shoe or boot) described on the cost sheets and in the specifications to a separate vendor or to award the contract in whole to a single vendor in accordance with what is in the best interest of the State.

The quantities listed on the bid form are approximations only and for the purpose of bid evaluation. These are estimates of yearly usage only and the quantity ordered may be more or less.

All delivery costs should be included in the bid price. All deliveries should be made during normal working hours and shall not be invoiced until the actual items are delivered to the delivery location. Agency shall have 30 days in which to return un-opened/un-used items at no charge. Vendor must provide packing slip in each order.

The vendor must be a manufacturer or a regular stocking, licensed dealer for the products offered at the time of bid.

The vendor should provide product information for the athletic shoes and boots quoted on this RFQ with their bid.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owned is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, Limited Liability Company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (*West Virginia Code* §61-5-3), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.
