**Detailed Description of Project:** The OpenFox Messaging Switch is a mission critical system that is used by all law enforcement agencies in the state of WV and allows other states and federal agencies access to WV's information. The switch gives access to the National Crime Information Center (NCIC), Criminal History (CHRI), and interfaces to various state agencies and Law Enforcement. This is the state repository for the information.

This project replaces the current OpenFox Message System and adds software functionality to the message switch.

- Replace current OpenFox Message System.
- Automatic failover between primary server and the secondary server located at the DR Site.
- Installation and optimization of OpenFox Software.
- Add functionality for new transaction MKE/CPI (Criminal Print Identification).
- Add functionality for new III unsolicited messages \$A.PES and \$A.PEM.
- Add logic to the Morpho Trak Automated Fingerprint Information System (AFIS) – CPI Criminal History Repository (CHRI) Interface.
- Modify Morpho Trak AFIS- CPI CCH interface for registry update errors.
- Provide single point of contact for the maintenance of the hardware and software for a period of three (3) years 24 X 7.
- Assure that hardware and software communicate correctly with each other.
- Interface with other State agencies in a secure manner.
- Comply with the Security Policy for CJIS Version 5.0 and NCIC 2000.
