GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

- 1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
- 2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
- 3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
- 4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
- 5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
- 6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the West Virginia Code.
- 8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
- 9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.

Technical Questions and Answers

Question #1: The RFQ calls for a 60 day completion date from the written notice to proceed. This is no were near enough time to complete the work required in this RFQ. Their are 23 buildings that require approximately 1 week per building (average). This adds up to 23 weeks or 115 working days. (Summarized in question form as "Would the Agency entertain the idea of allowing for longer project completion time?")

Answer#1: Please modify the time allowed for the project to be completed to 120 days from the issuance of the Notice to Proceed.

Question#2: This RFQ is asking that the existing fire panels in the listed buildings need to be integrated/migrated into the existing Tracer Summit Management System. To do this we will need copies of the programs (with device addresses and names) so that the integration/migration can be completed. Since the Agency is the owner of these fire panels and will have to request the copies, the Agency will have to provide these copies.

Answer#2: The Agency will furnish device (IP) addresses and any other required information to the Successful Bidder.

Question#3: This question is to clarify that that this RFQ does not include fire panel upgrades (hardware or software). This RFQ is to integrate/migrate the existing working fire panels into the Tracer Summit Management System.

Answer#3: The existing panels remain in place and will be connected to the TRACER system to the limits of the individual panel's design for notifications of alarms.
