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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
12. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

Part 1: DEFINITIONS

- A. The "Agency" shall be defined as the Division of Corrections, Huttonsville Correctional Center located at US Route 219/250, South Huttonsville, WV 26273.
- B. "Contractor" shall be defined as the successful bidder or vendor.
- C. "Contract" shall be defined as the binding agreement that is entered into between the State of West Virginia and the Contractor to provide the services as herein specified.
- D. "Preventative Maintenance" shall be defined as the scheduled inspections and the replacement of parts, components, and materials on the refrigeration equipment prior to the failure or wear-out period of the parts, components or materials. The planned inspections and replacements shall be in accordance with the equipment manufacturer's specifications and recommendations. No Preventive Maintenance shall be performed without authorization from the Agency, in the form of an approved release order.
- E. "Corrective Maintenance" shall be defined as maintenance performed as requested to correct a malfunction or failure in the kitchen equipment. No repair shall be performed without authorization from the Agency, in the form of an approved release order.
- F. "Agency Representative" shall be defined as the person designated by the Division of Corrections as having authority to act on behalf of the Agency.
- G. "Holidays" shall be defined as days designated by W.Va. Code §2-2-1 as legal holidays (i.e. new Year's Day, Martin Luther King's Birthday, President's Day, Memorial Day, West Virginia Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, Lincoln's Day, Election Days, and Christmas Day).
- H. "Testing" shall be defined as a function test upon the completion of an ordered Corrective Maintenance, Preventive Maintenance, and Overhaul services to ensure equipment is returned to normal operating mode or to determine if additional repairs are required.

PART 2: SCOPE OF WORK

The objective of this solicitation is to provide the Division of Corrections with a contract to cover the Preventative Maintenance, Corrective Maintenance, Testing and Inspection for various refrigeration systems in the identified buildings owned and operated by the West Virginia Division of Corrections. See Attachment A.

It is the intent of the Agency to have these services provided only as requested, meaning that the Agency will contact the successful bidder, by issuance of an Agency release order, prior to having any service or repair work performed. Preventive maintenance, Corrective Maintenance, Testing and Inspection service must be conducted to keep all equipment operating in accordance with manufacturer's specifications. Examples of work include but are not limited to:

1. Troubleshoot a variety of problems in the field with diagnostic devices to return equipment to service.
2. Repair or replace broken components of various refrigeration equipment including, but not limited to, motors, fans, blowers, controllers, relays, valves, control wiring, to return equipment to full function.
3. **The resulting contract shall no cover the addition of new refrigeration equipment, electrical or plumbing work, or any other construction. This contract covers existing equipment only.**

2.1 Required Services:

All preventive maintenance, corrective maintenance and testing performed hereunder shall be billed to the Agency at a single hourly rate regardless of the dated and time such services are performed.

Labor Warranty: The Contractor will furnish a warranty of 12 months for all labor performed under this contract.

2.2 Parts:

The Contractor shall provide and install all parts, components and materials to keep equipment operating in accordance with manufacturer's specifications. The Contractor shall supply all tools, tool accessories, personal safety equipment, and supplies necessary to execute the responsibilities of the contract. Non-reusable parts, components, and materials used in the scope of performing under this contract shall be supplied by the Contractor at no cost to the Agency. Such items may included grease, cleaning supplies, rate, etc.

The Contractor shall be required to receive approval from an authorized Agency representative(s) for replacement parts, components, or material prior to its purchase or requisition. Part(s) must be shipped in the most expeditious manner offered by the manufacturer unless the Agency, in its sole discretion, requires otherwise.

Parts Warranty: The Contractor shall provide a copy of the manufacturer's warranty on parts with the invoice.

2.3 Costs:

Maintenance, Testing and Inspection Services: The Contractor shall provide an all inclusive hourly rate for all services to be included under this contract. This hourly rate shall include all maintenance (corrective or preventive), testing and inspections. No overtime, weekend/holiday or additional emergency charges will be permitted. The Contractor will be responsible for all mileage and travel costs, including travel time, associated with the performance of this contract.

Parts: The contract shall provide parts to the Agency at the lowest possible cost. The Contractor shall price parts to the state based on his cost (list minus any discounts) multiplied by any mark-up required. The Contractor may be required to provide any and all price lists for audit purposes.

Freight: For Corrective Maintenance services parts orders authorized by the Agency, the Contractor may invoice for freight charges provided that it be gives as a pass through cost to the Agency. No mark-up shall be permitted for expedited delivery. (See Section 4.2 for more information).

The Contractor will be responsible for all mileage and travel costs, including travel time, associated with the performance of this Contract.

PART 3: MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

The Contractor shall have the minimum qualification outlined below to perform the services under this contract.

Vendor must be an authorized dealer for refrigeration systems. Vendor must have trained/certified technicians providing service on all equipment listed below. Vendor needs to provide license/certifications of technician providing service prior to beginning work on the equipment.

The qualified vendor shall have at least three years experience performing maintenance on refrigeration equipment. Bidders should supply with their bid, at least three references indicating their capabilities to perform such work. References should include name, location, ownership and used of the building.

By submitting a response to this RFQ, Contractor certifies that its employees that will perform services under the contract meet the minimum qualifications outlined above.

Huttonsville Correctional Center will provide assistance with a heavy load if needed to eliminate the need for an additional certified technician/helper. A Maintenance Supervisor will accompany all vendor employees throughout their work call at this facility.

If two certified technicians are needed to complete the call it needs to be approved by the Associate Warden of Operations or his designee to assure payment of invoice will be made.

PART 4: ORDERING AND INVOICING

4.1 Release Orders

The Agency shall define the scope of each job to be performed under this Contract. Prior to the beginning any work, the Contractor shall be required to provide a cost estimate detailing the intended scope of work, itemized by item and materials to the Agency. If approved, the Agency will issue a written release order to the Contractor. This release order shall have a unique number and reference the master contract number for the master contract. The release order shall indicate the scope of work for the job for which the release is used. Issuance of the release order to the Contractor shall be considered notice to proceed. No work other than that specified on the individual release order shall be undertaken by the Contractor.

The Contractor shall provide the Agency with valid email addresses and fax numbers to which release orders may be communicated.

4.2 Invoices

Invoices shall be submitted to the Agency for payment monthly (in arrears) and must include the following information:

1. Copies of all service orders or inspection reports signed and dated by the Agency Representative (prior to their submittal with invoices for payment).
2. Copy of suppliers' price list or invoice for each part, component, or material provided. Freight charges must be in accordance with Section 2.3. An expedited delivery charges for emergency repair service calls must be clearly indicated on the invoice and must be submitted to the Agency as a pass through cost. If third party freight, the Contractor must provide a copy of the freight invoice in order to receive payment.
3. The manufacturer's list price of the part(s), the discount applied, the total charge being requested, and the supplier's invoice number or page number of the attached price list. Copies of the supplier's price list or invoices must match, in order, the order by which parts appear on the Contractor's invoice.
4. FEIN number, complete address of Contractor, release order number, and master contract number.

Should the Contractor be requested by the Agency or volunteer to submit invoices electronically, invoices must meet the digital requirements of the WV State Auditor's Office.

PART 5: ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

5.1 The relationship of the Contractor to the State of West Virginia shall be that of an independent Contractor and no principal-agent relationship or employer-employee relationship is contemplated or created by the parties to this Contract. The Contractor, as an independent Contractor, is solely liable for the acts and omissions of its employees and agents. The Contractor will be responsible for selecting, supervising, and compensating any and all individuals employed pursuant to the terms of this Contract. Neither the Contractor nor any employees or sub-Contractors of the Contractor shall be deemed to be employees of the State for any purposes whatsoever. The wages and salaries, taxes, withholding payments, penalties, fees, fringe benefits, professional liability insurance premiums, contributions to insurance and pension or other deferred obligations, and licensing fees, etc., and the filing of all necessary documents, forms and returns pertinent to all of the foregoing are the Contractor's responsibility. The Contractor shall hold harmless the State of West Virginia and the Agency and shall provide the State of West Virginia and the Agency with a defense against any and all claims including but not limited to, the foregoing payments, withholdings, contributions, taxes, social security taxes and employer income tax returns. The Contractor shall not assign, convey, transfer, sub-contract, or delegate any of its responsibilities and obligations under this Contract to any person, corporation, partnership, association, or entity without express written consent of the Agency.

5.2 Indemnification: The Contractor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the State and the Agency, their officers, and employees from and against (1) any claims or losses for services rendered by any subcontractor, person or firm performing or supplying services, materials, or supplies in connection with the performance of the Contract; (2) any claims or losses resulting to any person or entity injured or damaged by the Contractor, its officers, employees, or subcontractors by the publication, translation, reproduction, delivery, performance, use, or disposition of any data used under the Contract in a manner not authorized by the Contract, or by federal or state statutes or regulations; and (3) any failure of the Contractor, its officers, employees or sub-contractors to observe state and federal laws, including but not limited to labor and wage laws.

5.3 The Contractor further agrees to comply with the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all other applicable federal, state and local government regulations.

5.4 All work, materials, and equipment shall comply with the rules and regulations of all codes and ordinances of local, state and federal authorities. At a minimum, the services and repairs shall comply with the current editions in effect 30 days prior to precept of bids of the following codes:

1. National Electric Code (NEC)
2. International Building Code (IBC)
3. International Mechanical Code (IMC)
4. Underwriters Laboratories: Products shall UL-916-PAZX listed.
5. ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 135-2004 (BACnet)
6. ANSI/EIA/CEA-709.1 (LonTalk)

7. NFPA (National Fire Protection Association)
8. Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

5.5 The Contractor shall procure all necessary permits and licenses to comply with all applicable laws, federal, state or municipal along with all regulations and ordinances of any regulating body.

5.6 The Contractor shall pay any applicable sales, use or personal property taxes arising out of this Contract and the transactions contemplated thereby. Any other taxes levied upon this contract, the transaction, or the equipment, or services delivered pursuant hereto shall be borne by the Contractor. It is clearly understood that the State of West Virginia is exempt from any taxes regarding performance of the scope of work of this contract.

PART 6: AWARD CRITERIA

Award shall be based on the lowest combination of hourly rate and parts mark-up per the attached bid scenario below. The amounts of hours and the aggregate expenditures on both types of supplied parts are estimates, used only as a basis for award of the Contract. Actual amounts required during the life of the contract may be greater or lower.

Following is a sample bid tabulation for reference purposes only:

Flat Hourly Rate \$ 60.00 X 300 hours = \$ 18,000.00 (A)

Cost for parts \$6,000 X Mark-up (25%) 1.25 = \$ 7,500.00 (B)

*NOTE: The multiplier listed above is derived by taking the parts mark-up listed and converting it to a multiplier factor. For example, a 25% mark-up would equal a multiplier of 1.25.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.

Under penalty of law for false swearing (*West Virginia Code §61-5-3*), it is hereby certified that the vendor affirms and acknowledges the information in this affidavit and is in compliance with the requirements as stated.
