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GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) AND REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)

1. Awards will be made in the best interest of the State of West Virginia.
2. The State may accept or reject in part, or in whole, any bid.
3. Prior to any award, the apparent successful vendor must be properly registered with the Purchasing Division and have paid the required \$125 fee.
4. All services performed or goods delivered under State Purchase Order/Contracts are to be continued for the term of the Purchase Order/Contracts, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise available for these services or goods this Purchase Order/Contract becomes void and of no effect after June 30.
5. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services.
6. Interest may be paid for late payment in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
7. Vendor preference will be granted upon written request in accordance with the *West Virginia Code*.
8. The State of West Virginia is exempt from federal and state taxes and will not pay or reimburse such taxes.
9. The Director of Purchasing may cancel any Purchase Order/Contract upon 30 days written notice to the seller.
10. The laws of the State of West Virginia and the *Legislative Rules* of the Purchasing Division shall govern the purchasing process.
11. Any reference to automatic renewal is hereby deleted. The Contract may be renewed only upon mutual written agreement of the parties.
12. **BANKRUPTCY:** In the event the vendor/contractor files for bankruptcy protection, the State may deem this contract null and void, and terminate such contract without further order.

Part 1 GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1 Purpose:

The Acquisition and Contract Administration Section of the Purchasing Division "State" for the Department of Health and Human Resources, Bureau for Behavioral Health Facilities, Welch Community Hospital, "Agency" is soliciting quotations to provide an open end contract for the rental of one (1) liquid cryogenic vessel (single) and one (1) reserve tank and the purchase of gasses and supplies for Welch Community Hospital.

1.2 Project:

The mission or purpose of this project is to provide on a continuous basis, rental of one (1) liquid cryogenic vessel (single) and one (1) reserve tank and the purchase of gasses and supplies.

Part 2 OPERATING ENVIRONMENT

2.1 Location:

Facility is located in McDowell County at Welch Community Hospital, 454 McDowell Street, Welch WV 24801

2.2 Background:

Welch Community Hospital is a 124 bed hospital, 59 of which are long term care beds. Acute care beds include: 8 intensive care beds; 2 pediatric beds; 10 obstetrical beds and 45 medical/surgical beds. The hospital serves the counties of McDowell, Wyoming and Mingo with a total market population of about 83,000.

Part 3 PROCUREMENT SPECIFICATIONS

3.1 General Requirements:

The mission/purpose of this project is to provide rental of one (1) liquid cryogenic vessel (single) and one (1) reserve vessel and the purchase of gasses and supplies.

3.2 Scope of Work:

The Vendor is requested to quote services limited to providing rental of one (1) liquid cryogenic vessel (single) and one (1) reserve vessel, and the purchase of gasses and supplies consistent with all applicable State and Federal laws and regulations. Monthly rental shall be cryogenic vessel and the reserve tank.

More specifically, Vendor shall include, but not be limited to the following:

- a. Vendor shall provide rental of one (1) liquid cryogenic vessel (single) and one (1) reserve vessel and the purchase of gasses and supplies, for a 125-bed facility using approximately 3200 SCF per month and a reserve tank that would allow 48 hour supply based on 185# of liquid per day.
- b. Vendor's vessel shall provide dual safeties to allow hospital personnel to switch tank pressure to a new rupture disc in the event one disc were to blow due to excessive pressure.
- c. Vendor must use economizer circuits (minimizes vent loss by withdrawing head pressure from vessel into the houseline, switch over controls should be housed in thermal plastic material and be non-corrosive as well). All switches in control unit must comply with all applicable State and Federal laws and regulations and shall be of the following type:
 1. Reserve in use.
 2. Low pressure in reserve.
 3. Liquid level gauge on the cryogenic vessel to signal "low liquid level" must also be installed.
- d. The bodies of the regulators contained in the control unit shall be constructed of brass rather than aluminum for superior oxygen compatibility.
- e. Vendor's installation shall contain a pressure temperature control which will shut down the system in the event vaporization was to become inadequate, thus preventing liquid from entering the houseline.
- f. Vendor's installation shall have a minimum of a 24 hour reserve in accordance with all applicable State and Federal laws and regulations.
- g. Vendor shall provide delivery of storage vessels at no cost to the facility.
- h. Vendor shall provide crane to off load and set vessel on pad.
- i. Vendor shall furnish labor and materials to pipe up installation, which includes dual safeties and pressure temperature control manifold.
- j. Vendor shall install fill connection for liquid vessel.
- k. Vendor shall cool tank and set regulators to supply desired houseline pressure.
- l. Vendor shall furnish sufficient vaporization to handle volume usage requirements.

- m. Vendor shall deliver oxygen as required from closest manufacturing facility or other production plant as needed.
- n. Vendor shall provide engineering assistance and total support for the liquid oxygen system.
- o. Vendor shall provide switches for a three (3) function alarm system to be interfaced with current alarm panel that will signify low oxygen level for the main vessel, signify reserve oxygen vessel in use, and to indicate low oxygen level for the reserve vessel.
- p. Monthly rental shall include all equipment, installation and maintenance of liquid cryogenic vessel.
- q. Vendor will provide facility with CofA/CofC (Certificate of Analysis/Certificate of Conformance) document as required complying with all applicable State and Federal laws and regulations.

3.3 Special Terms and Conditions:

3.3.1 Performance Bonds:

The successful vendor will be required to furnish a performance bond in the amount of 100% of the vendor bid submitted. A performance bond may be in the form of a policy or certificate issued by a surety company recognized as doing business in the State of West Virginia. The bond must be submitted on a form available from the Purchasing Division. A cashier's check made payable to the State of West Virginia may be accepted in lieu of the policy or certificate issued by the surety company. A Performance bond is not required until requested by the Purchasing Division.

The Performance bond is forfeited to the State if the vendor defaults in the performance of a purchase order after the order had been issued and work has begun.

3.3.2 Insurance Requirements:

Insurance certificates are required prior to award but are not required at the time of bid. The vendor shall present evidence of insurance at the time of award in the types and amounts required by the Agency and acceptable to the State. Included in the required insurance coverage shall be the following:

1. For bodily injury (including death); \$500,000 per person, minimum of \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
2. For property damage and professional liability; minimum of \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

The State of West Virginia shall be named the Certificate Holder.

3.3.3 Invoices and Progress Payments:

Then Vendor shall submit invoices, in arrears, to the Agency at the address on the face of the purchase order labeled "Invoice To" pursuant to the terms of the contract. Invoices may not be submitted more than once monthly and State Law forbids payment of invoices prior to receipt of services.

Part 4 Term of Contract:

This contract shall be for the period of one year with the option of two (2) one (1) year renewals.

Part 5 Cost Evaluation:

Award will be based on the overall lowest cost that meets specifications.

It is preferred that each responder use the cost proposal sheet provided.

Part 6 Coordination of Work:

- 8.1 Successful bidder shall coordinate the install and testing with the Respiratory Manager and Maintenance Manager.
- 8.2 Successful bidder shall provide the Respiratory Manager and Maintenance Manager with a time schedule for completing installation and testing.

Application is made for 2.5% resident vendor preference for the reason checked: Bidder is a nonresident vendor employing a minimum of one hundred state residents or is a nonresident vendor with an affiliate or subsidiary which maintains its headquarters or principal place of business within West Virginia employing a minimum of one hundred state residents who certifies that, during the life of the contract, on average at least 75% of the employees or Bidder's affiliate's or subsidiary's employees are residents of West Virginia who have resided in the state continuously for the two years immediately preceding submission of this bid; or,
4. Application is made for 5% resident vendor preference for the reason checked: Bidder meets either the requirement of both subdivisions (1) and (2) or subdivision (1) and (3) as stated above; or,

Bidder understands if the Secretary of Revenue determines that a Bidder receiving preference has failed to continue to meet the requirements for such preference, the Secretary may order the Director of Purchasing to: (a) reject the bid; or (b) assess a penalty against such Bidder in an amount not to exceed 5% of the bid amount and that such penalty will be paid to the contracting agency or deducted from any unpaid balance on the contract or purchase order.

By submission of this certificate, Bidder agrees to disclose any reasonably requested information to the Purchasing Division and authorizes the Department of Revenue to disclose to the Director of Purchasing appropriate information verifying that Bidder has paid the required business taxes, provided that such information does not contain the amounts of taxes paid nor any other information deemed by the Tax Commissioner to be confidential.

PURCHASING AFFIDAVIT

West Virginia Code §5A-3-10a states: No contract or renewal of any contract may be awarded by the state or any of its political subdivisions to any vendor or prospective vendor when the vendor or prospective vendor or a related party to the vendor or prospective vendor is a debtor and the debt owed is an amount greater than one thousand dollars in the aggregate.

DEFINITIONS:

"Debt" means any assessment, premium, penalty, fine, tax or other amount of money owed to the state or any of its political subdivisions because of a judgment, fine, permit violation, license assessment, defaulted workers' compensation premium, penalty or other assessment presently delinquent or due and required to be paid to the state or any of its political subdivisions, including any interest or additional penalties accrued thereon.

"Debtor" means any individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association owing a debt to the state or any of its political subdivisions. "Political subdivision" means any county commission; municipality; county board of education; any instrumentality established by a county or municipality; any separate corporation or instrumentality established by one or more counties or municipalities, as permitted by law; or any public body charged by law with the performance of a government function or whose jurisdiction is coextensive with one or more counties or municipalities. "Related party" means a party, whether an individual, corporation, partnership, association, limited liability company or any other form or business association or other entity whatsoever, related to any vendor by blood, marriage, ownership or contract through which the party has a relationship of ownership or other interest with the vendor so that the party will actually or by effect receive or control a portion of the benefit, profit or other consideration from performance of a vendor contract with the party receiving an amount that meets or exceed five percent of the total contract amount.

EXCEPTION: The prohibition of this section does not apply where a vendor has contested any tax administered pursuant to chapter eleven of this code, workers' compensation premium, permit fee or environmental fee or assessment and the matter has not become final or where the vendor has entered into a payment plan or agreement and the vendor is not in default of any of the provisions of such plan or agreement.
