The length of the contract is 1 year.

The length of the Performance Period is 365 days.

Stanley Mathis will be the WVDEP agent on site.

OSHA safety requirements prevail on this project.

CLARIFICATIONS OF THE SCOPE OF WORK, LISTED BY PERMIT NUMBER

S-3007-89

In reference to Bid Item # 3:

- The haul road access road bid item shall include cleaning the ditch line from the gate, coming off
 of the county road, to the first left turn to go up the hill to keep this road draining. Clean the
 ditch line, clean the culverts and that will be included and incidental to your haul road bid item.
- On the haul road coming up the hill, clean any debris that is obstructing out of the ditch line and clean any culverts as well, you do not have to clean the entire ditch line coming up the hill, but you do need to clean anything that is obstructing.

In the Light Industrial Area: All debris here on the flat, stays. As well as all other equipment and debris in the Light Industrial Area, the box trailers, tires, loaders, fuel wagon in sediment ditch, powder magazine all stays because this area is designated as light industrial.

If the successful bidder has a question about what is to be removed, they should ask Stanley Mathis, the WVDEP agent on site.

In reference to construction of Temporary Access Road for Pond 2

- This is off bonded area, the adjacent landowner has granted us permission to gain access through here to access and reclaim Pond 2. You are NOT to access Pond 2 from the county road.
- The property owner has requested that all trees removed during access road construction be placed adjacent to Pond I. Root balls are to be cut off and placed in bottom of Pond I along with any wood less than 12-inches in diameter. Basically, when you construct your access road, any trees you need to grub out or trees which root balls are exposed, you are going to remove for the property owner, you will take up here onto the flat, you are going to cut the root balls off, and cut the tops off, less than 12-inches.
- Any trees that you break the tops out of, trees that are going to die because you cut an adjacent one down, shall be also cut and taken up to Pond I, you do not have to grub that tree, but any trees you break the tops off by removing another tree, you need to take it as well. We do not want to leave the property owner with dead trees standing along his property. Any trees that you expose the roots while constructing the access road, you need to go ahead and grub that tree out, take the whole tree up on top, cut the root balls off, cut anything less than 12-inches in diameter off and push it in his pond. It is the dry pond up there that is his.
- You will come in the temporary access road, about where the old truck was. You are not going to go down toward the property owners' yard and built a road over the hill in front of his house. You are going to come in here at the edge of the permit and work your way down to the corner of the pond. Contractor will not receive additional payment from WV DEP for tree removal operations.

In reference to Bid Item # 7.1: Pond 2 Elimination:

- Use caution when dewatering Pond 2. The stream channel below is small and drains down through some yards, and the existing tile pipe is half plugged, so I suggest you use a small pump when you dewater it or we are all going to have problems with the neighbors.
- If you need material to provide positive drainage, you can get it from Sediment Ditch 2 area.
- You shall lay the silt bag, on the grass embankment, on a hay bale bed, and if necessary, we may
 use hay bale dike, silt fence and sumps as well.
- About 15 feet below the toe of this embankment is where the property line is, so do not get
 more than 10-15 feet below the toe or you will be encroaching on someone else's property,
 which we DO NOT have permission to cross.

The entirety of Sediment Ditch 2 to be eliminated is basically from the cat tails on the right where it terminates, around the slope down to the left of the ribbons.

We are not going to bury trees here, we are going to burn or chip them, and you will be responsible for getting the burn permits or you can chip and spread on the permitted area. There will be some trees on the out slopes of all of these ditches that you will have to take out. We will not bury them; they will be burned or chipped.

5-3027-90

In reference to Pond I area - Topdress from the orange ribbon on this side to the orange ribbon on the other side from the toe of the slope up to the rim of the pond. The bottom of this pond is the area where the root balls and small woody material will be disposed of. The logs will remain on the flat area for the land owner, the root balls cut off and material less than 12 inches will go in the bottom for him to take care of.

In reference to Bid Item 20.1: Supplemental Pond Elimination:

- Fold the outer berm in. Construct two rip rap channels: Both from opposite corners of the pond opposite of the existing spillway.
- Maintaining minimal disturbance use as much of the berm material as you can and any slopes that you generate must be no steeper than 2:1 (horizontal to vertical) and drain toward the proposed channels.

In reference to Bid Item 20.2: Sediment Ditch G Elimination:

- The trees will have to be cut off this slope before you fold it in. The trees cut are not going to be buried; they have to be burned or chipped. If chipped, they can be spread on the permitted area surface.
- There is an existing access road that will be utilized to access the area for Sediment Ditch G
 Elimination.

In reference to Bid Item 35.1 – Rip Rap Channel 5; the existing rip rap channel will be extended to the out slope.

In reference to Bid Item 35.2 - Rip Rap Channel 6; channel to be installed between the areas approximately marked with ribbon. The remainder of the road will be regraded and water barred to reduce erosion. If there is any debris in the road way ditch impeding the flow, remove it. You do not have to clean the entire ditch, just where there is debris impeding flow, from the toe of the hill to the top.

At ending roll call, Jones Excavating was not present.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS (Asked at pre-bid meeting on 4 September 2012).

Question 1: It used to be if we had a question after the pre-bid, we could ask it. Are they saying now we can't?

Answer 1: That is what the Request for Solicitation says.

Question 2: When it says write it in writing, it has to be done here (at the pre-bid meeting)? So after today we can't ask any more questions?

Answer 2: According to the Request for Solicitation yes, that is what the Purchasing Division has decided. Mike Sheehan added: We are working to get clarification on that.

Question 3: I did not put my fax number down, is it required?

Answer 3: I think that it is your company address that is required, but if you have one go ahead and put one down.

Question 4: On the haul road, is it listed as lump sum? You don't have a footage listed.

Answer 4: It is on your bid schedule, yes.

Question 5: Do you have a detail? (In reference to cleaning the ditch line and culverts along the haul road.)

Answer 5: No, clean the existing ditch line and the culverts.

Question 6: To what depth and width?

Answer 6: Clean debris out to where it free drains.

Question 7: When you say culverts too, do we have to flush them out?

Answer 7: Just clean the inlets out and remove debris. If there is debris stuck in them, then it will have to be cleaned out.

Question 8: What do we do with material out of the ditch line? Take it up on top somewhere? Answer 8: Any debris goes in the wide areas along the road. However, we do not want any mud piled up along access road. It can be taken up on top and disposed of in areas designated to be regraded.

Question 9: Is that debris part of this? (Referring to the old red truck/ frame)

Answer 9: No, this stays here; it is the property owner's do not take the truck or any other junk lying around it either.

Question 10: Are all of the ponds and sediment ditches coming out?

Answer 10: No, just the ones we are designating for elimination are to be eliminated; some of them have MR-12's on them and are staying.

Question 11: Where's the pond where we are going to put the stumps and logs at?

Answer 11: It is on top, we will get to it in two stops from now.

Question 12: Is there any water in it? (Referring to Pond I)

Answer 12: No, it is a dry pond.

Question 13: The dry pond, where the brush goes, where's it at?

Answer 13: That is where we are headed now.

Question 14: Flat area? You mean up here on top? (In reference to Pond I, where the trees larger than 12" can be placed.)

Answer 14: Yes, put the logs up here on the outside of the pond.

Question 15: Is positive drainage required? (In reference to construction of Rip Rap Channels 2 and 3) Answer 15: Yes, that is correct, to the two proposed Rip Rap Channels and to the existing spillway. No slopes steeper than 2:1 (horizontal to vertical).

Question 16: Does (construction of Rip Rap Channel 4) have to be done prior to dewatering the pond? (In reference Bid Item # 23.3: Rip Rap Channel 4)

Answer 16: No.

Question 17: Is that Riprap Channel 5? (In reference to Riprap Channel 5 area)

Answer17: Yes

Question 18: Are we regrading the whole width of the road? (In reference to Bid Item 28 – Haulroad/Access Road)

Answer 18: We are not taking out the safety berm or the boulders. You are regrading from the safety berm over to make sure that the flow goes into the ditch line.

Question 19: Can the trees be cut down? (Referring to the trees along the road being regraded in Bid Item # 28)

Answer 19: If you need to cut down trees to regrade the road, then cut down the trees.

Question 20: Do we put filter fabric underneath our riprap ditches?

Answer 20: No.

Question 21: What do we do with our silt bags?

Answer 21: As stated in the specifications; sediment from filter bags may be left onsite and vegetated, however filter bags must be disposed of offsite. They cannot be buried on site they need to be disposed of properly.

Question 22: When do you expect the work to begin?

Answer 22: If processed in time, we would like to start this fall.
