The Pre-Bid meeting was conducted on site by Dale Withrow, Manager Architecture at Chapman Technical Group.

- 3. The State Solicitation / Request for Quotation was discussed.
 - a. Interested bidders must obtain the RFQ from WV Purchasing. The RFQ contains pertinent information regarding the bidding of the project including the Form of Proposal, Bid Bond, and other requisite forms and information that must accompany the bids to be considered as responsive.
 - b. All questions pertaining to the project shall be directed to Dean Wingerd via fax at 304-558-4115 or email at dean.c.wingerd@wv.gov.
 - c. Subsequent to the pre-bid meeting there can be no questions of Scott Morrison or Chapman Technical Group. Any questions about the bidding process or technical questions pertaining to the project must be directed to Mr. Wingerd for consideration.
 - d. The last day for all questions is April 21, 2014 at 5:00 PM.
- 4. Reviewed the bidding process:
 - a. Bid opening date is April 29, 2014 at 1:30 PM at WV Purchasing Division in Charleston.
 - b. This is a mandatory pre-bid. Sign in sheets were distributed and gathered and copies accompany these notes.
 - c. Bidders must be a registered contractor with the State.
 - d. The bid form in the RFQ is to be used unaltered. It was explained that the unit prices call for one cost to be added to or deleted from the contract amount in the event the actual documented quantities of work completed is more or less than indicated. It was emphasized that this is one price per unit; alteration of the bid to indicate a different price to be added than deducted could render the bid unresponsive.
 - e. This is a prevailing wage job. The applicable wage rates are available on the state website. Information is contained in the RFQ.
 - f. Time of full completion for this project is 150 days.
 - g. Liquidated damages will be addressed by addendum.

- h. Addenda: there will be at least one addendum for the project which will include notes of this meeting along with copies of the sign in sheet. Other addenda will be issued if needed to address questions that arise during the bidding process, up to 5:00 PM April 21, 2014.
 - 1. Any statement made by anybody during this pre-bid meeting that materially alters the work described in the plans and specifications is not to be considered unless documented by addendum.
 - 2. Questions and answers today will be in addendum.
 - 3. Bidders must acknowledge receipt of all addenda as directed in RFQ.
- i. The basis of award for the contract will be the Base Bid only. The unit prices discussed are to be used only after the contract sum has been established and the work has commenced as explained in the project manual and on the Form of Proposal.
- 5. Miscellaneous Project Information.
 - a. Access to work site is unrestricted; there are no gates or check points to enter the site. There should be sufficient clear space around the buildings for scaffolding or lifts as needed for the work. The owner's representative on site will work with the contractor as needed for access within the buildings.
 - b. Work hours there are no restrictions on work hours for the project. The facility is open from 8:30 to 4:30 and the Lock Building function will continue as normal. The Lockmaster's Residence is not normally occupied.
 - c. Pay requests by the Contractor should be submitted on a monthly basis using the standard AIA Forms G702 and G703, Application and Certificate for Payment and Continuation Sheet.
 - d. The Contractor shall be responsible for maintaining security and safety at the construction site?

6. Questions and Answers:

1. What is the amount of time for the construction?

The entire project is to be completed within the 150 days indicated in the RFQ. Note: This is full completion, not to Substantial completion as stated on site.

2. Any idea of the amount of Liquidated Damages?

The amount of Liquidated Damages will be discussed with the Purchaser and indicated in the addendum.

3. What type of warranty is required for the shingle roof at the Lockmaster's Residence?

In addition to the manufacturer's warranty and the installer's warranty listed in the Project Manual, the State requires a two year Maintenance Bond and is addressed in the RFQ.

4. Will the spindle for the ball finial be reused or would a cap of some sort be used in its place?

The decorative ball finial that was knocked from the top of the Tower Roof on the Lock Building is intact and currently situated on the roof of the Lock Building. This ball finial is to be reset. For purposes of bidding it should be assumed that the ball finial and spindle can be reused and reset.

5. Will any type of underlayment be used over the rough cut decking of the Lockmaster's House? There is a concern that the rough lumber will telegraph through the new shingle roof.

The entire roof of the Lockmaster's House shall receive 7/16 inch CDX (Grade C-D, exterior glue) plywood as an underlayment / roof sheathing. The plywood shall be screwed to the existing rafters in accordance with the fastening schedule manufacturer's recommended fastening. This is a change to the design.

12. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: Vendor shall pay liquidated damages in the amount \$250.00 per day for every day past full completion date.

This clause shall in no way be considered exclusive and shall not limit the State or Agency's right to pursue any other available remedy.

- **13. ACCEPTANCE/REJECTION:** The State may accept or reject any bid in whole, or in part. Vendor's signature on its bid signifies acceptance of the terms and conditions contained in the Solicitation and Vendor agrees to be bound by the terms of the Contract, as reflected in the Purchase Order, upon receipt.
- **14. REGISTRATION:** Prior to Contract award, the apparent successful Vendor must be properly registered with the West Virginia Purchasing Division and must have paid the \$125 fee if applicable.
- 1-6.6, communication with the State of West Virginia or any of its employees regarding this Solicitation during the solicitation, bid, evaluation or award periods, except through the Purchasing Division, is strictly prohibited without prior Purchasing Division approval. Purchasing Division approval for such communication is implied for all agency delegated and exempt purchases.
- **16. FUNDING:** This Contract shall continue for the term stated herein, contingent upon funds being appropriated by the Legislature or otherwise being made available. In the event funds are not appropriated or otherwise made available, this Contract becomes void and of no effect beginning on July 1 of the fiscal year for which funding has not been appropriated or otherwise made available.
- 17. PAYMENT: Payment in advance is prohibited under this Contract. Payment may only be made after the delivery and acceptance of goods or services. The Vendor shall submit invoices, in arrears, to the Agency at the address on the face of the purchase order labeled "Invoice To."
- **18. UNIT PRICE:** Unit prices shall prevail in cases of a discrepancy in the Vendor's bid.
- 19. DELIVERY: All quotations are considered freight on board destination ("F.O.B. destination") unless alternate shipping terms are clearly identified in the bid. Vendor's listing of shipping terms that contradict the shipping terms expressly required by this Solicitation may result in bid disqualification.
- **20. INTEREST:** Interest attributable to late payment will only be permitted if authorized by the West Virginia Code. Presently, there is no provision in the law for interest on late payments.
- 21. PREFERENCE: Vendor Preference may only be granted upon written request and only in accordance with the West Virginia Code § 5A-3-37 and the West Virginia Code of State Rules. A Resident Vendor Certification form has been attached hereto to allow Vendor to apply for the preference. Vendor's
