This Addendum forms a part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original bidding documents as noted below.

Pre-Bid Conference Information and Clarifications:

Attendees: See attached sign-in sheet(s).

All questions regarding this project must be submitted in writing to the Division of Purchasing, contact information is in the project manual. Addenda will be only issued by the Division of Purchasing.

The Pre-Bid Conference was intended to provide a general introduction to the project and the site conditions. Only responses included in formal Addenda shall be relied upon as requirements of the project. This includes discussion during the meeting or any dialogue with representative of the WV DNR Engineering, Park personnel, or the Design Team.

- Recent changes have been made to the state purchasing "Instructions to Vendors and Terms and Conditions" related to bidding. Contractors should pay careful attention to these changes. Also noted: contractors should closely follow all instructions to bidders when filling out bid forms and providing supplemental information.
- 2. It was specifically mentioned that the apparent low bidders will be required to provide a list of subcontractors within 24 hours of bid opening.
- 3. Clarification on date of substitutions as outlined in the Information to Bidders "Requests for approval of substitutions must be addressed to and received by the Engineer, Division of Natural Resources, Park and Recreation Section, c/o Dean Wingerd, Purchasing Division, 2019 Washington Street, East, Charleston, WV 25305, and to be given consideration must be received by the date of the cut-off for technical questions."
- 4. This is a prevailing wage project.
- 5. The Park/Museum will remain open while this Work is being performed. Museum hours are 8am to 5pm, and closed on Mondays. Park grounds and parking areas are accessible by the public 24 hours/7 days per week. Safe access and egress must be maintained at all times. Safety and security of guests, staff personnel, and the building/contents must be maintained at all times. Any especially disruptive construction activities should be scheduled during the museum's closed hours.

- 6. The work area must be flagged, fenced, signed, etc. Contractor is responsible for all safety. Clean-up must be thorough. Contractor is responsible for providing their own dumpster. Coordinate location with Park personnel.
- 7. Be courteous of guests and staff. Coordinate any utility disruptions, anticipated noise, and any other disruptions with Park personnel. A minimum of 24 hour notice of any disruptions to power, communication, traffic, parking, use of sidewalks, extreme noise, etc. is required.
- 8. Contractor is responsible for protecting the building and its contents from moisture, dust, etc. entering the building due to this Work. Any issues resulting from areas being unprotected will be the responsibility of the contractor.
- Be cautious of utilities. Contractor is responsible for any damages created by this
  Work. No shut down times can occur. If utilities need disconnected, contractor is
  responsible for providing temporary provisions approved by DNR. Coordinate any
  disruptions with Park personnel.
- 10. Any Testing, B & O taxes, and Obtaining of any Licenses, permits, certifications, and warranties will be the responsibility of the contractor.
- 11. Electricity and water will be available to the contractor for this work. A small section of designated parking spaces can be used for staging and contractor parking. Coordinate use of these with Park personnel.
- 12. Park restrooms will be available during museum open hours.
- 13. List of pre-bid attendees is attached.

#### Technical Questions and Responses DNR214127

Question 1:

Most major equipment representatives said they cannot meet the 92% furnace that will give you the required air flow for the 12.5 and 15 Ton units.

Answer 1:

Reznor's series CAUA furnace and coil; and Reznor series MASA Condensing units will meet the requirements of the project except the 92% efficiency requirement. The standard non condensing efficiency of the Reznor unit is acceptable for the project.

Question 2:

After another walk through of the site and checking the duct sizing along with the area for sizing for the equipment, here is what I found. Two (2) 10 Ton systems per floor are more than adequate and would give you better de-humidification. The basement unit is way oversized and should be re-sized. Therefore can we quote the project this way?

Answer 2:

The Reznor units above are 2 stage up to 7.5 ton and 3 stage 10 ton and up. These units should adapt to load conditions well, they are capable of up to 1.3" of static, and can meet the CFM requirements of the project.

Question 3:

All 95% furnaces, three (3) 10 Ton condensers, line sets, and coils. One (1) 5 Ton for basement with new air handler and two (2) new coils on the first floor south system. This way all equipment will be matched and will meet all AHRI equipment ratings and the EPA efficiency required ratings.

Answer 3:

All units in the first floor and second floor will be replaced with the aforementioned units as complete systems to include: furnace, cooling coil, line sets, condenser, control wiring, thermostats (digital, programmable, multi stage, 7 day), and inlet and venting to meet both code and manufacturer's requirements. The basement system will be an electric air handler with variable speed ECM blower with 2 stage/ 2 speed 5 ton heat pump, with 30KW aux heat, and low speed dehumidification capability. Carrier Infinity Series will be the basis with approval of substitutions by the Engineer in the submittal phase.

The DNR has included CD's with a complete set of floor plans to be mailed out to the vendors listed on the mandatory pre-bid meeting sign-in sheet
