#### AMENDMENT No. 9 to MASTER AGREEMENT# 5737

I. This is Amendment No. 9 to Master Agreement #5737, ("Amendment No. 9"), dated June 11, 2019, ("Amendment No. 9 Effective Date"), is between the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Department of Administrative Services, Procurement Services office ("DAS PS") on behalf of the member states of the NASPO ValuePoint Cooperative Purchasing Program, and Office Depot, Inc., ("Contractor"), and amends that certain Master Agreement #5737, dated as of December 19, 2014 (the "Master Agreement"), on the terms and conditions as provided herein.

II. The Master Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

- a. The parties acknowledge and agree to extend the Master Agreement as defined in Section 1.5 of the Master Agreement. This Master Agreement shall be extended for an additional 3-year term. The new expiration date shall be December 19, 2022.
- b. All Master Agreement terms and conditions shall remain firm and in effect throughout the term of the Master Agreement.
- III. Except as expressly amended above, all other terms and conditions of the Price Agreement are still in full force and effect. Contractor certifies that the representations, warranties and certifications contained in the Price Agreement are true and correct as of the Amendment Effective Date and with the same effect as though made at the time of execution of the Price Agreement.

#### AMENDMENT No. 10 to MASTER AGREEMENT# 5737

I. This is Amendment No. 10 to Master Agreement #5737, ("Amendment No. 10"), dated September 23, 2019, ("Amendment No. 10 Effective Date"), is between the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Department of Administrative Services, Procurement Services office ("DAS PS") on behalf of the member states of the NASPO ValuePoint Cooperative Purchasing Program, and Office Depot, Inc., ("Contractor"), and amends that certain Master Agreement #5737, dated as of December 19, 2014 (the "Master Agreement"), on the terms and conditions as provided herein.

### II. The Master Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

- a. The parties acknowledge and agree that Contractor, as a result of its annual catalog review process and publication, has updated the "Contract Catalog Products" as defined in Section 1.3.1(b) of the Master Agreement. This update may add and delete items to the "Contract Catalog Products," which may modify list pricing, (either increase or decrease), and may re-categorize items as per Contractor's standard classifications. Such update shall be provided to DAS PS for approval; Contractor shall send DAS PS notice of its price change(s), which are only effective after DAS PS has approved and accepted such changes. Pricing changes are in effect starting November 9, 2019.
- b. Per Section 1.3.4 of the Master Agreement, the discount percentages or amount off of the forty-nine (49) categories of Goods listed in Exhibit B will remain the same.
- c. Any approved pricing will be updated and changed on Contractor's On-Line Ordering Tool: http://www.officemaxworkplace.com or http://www.business.officedepot.com. This price change affects the Market Basket, Full Line Catalog, SP Richards Catalogs, and the RISI Paper.
