The West Virginia Veterans Nursing Facility is requesting approval for an emergency contract for Rehabilitative Therapy services for a term not to exceed six (6) months. Although specifications were drafted for this, the revision process has taken longer than expected due to the complexity of the services being solicited. We don't expect it will take the full six months, but we want to allow enough time for the new bid, responses, evaluation and award. We'd also like to include a stipulation to the effect that the emergency contract may be cancelled upon award of a new contract.

The current contract expires on February 28, 2019. This contract covers Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Speech Therapy. These therapies offer essential benefits of reducing pain, inflammation and swelling, encourage healing, limiting stress, improving mobility and avoiding surgery. These services are vital to the health and well-being of our residents. The cost for these services has been approximately \$45,000 per month, so the estimated cost for six (6) months spend is \$540,000.
