WV AML received a call from Ms. Shirley Tincher on December 27, 2021 stating that smoke from an apparent mine fire was prevalent in the community in which she lives. Ms. Tincher further stated that she has respiratory problems and the smoke and furnes are affecting her health. Ms. Tincher lives in the community of Bloomingrose in Boone County. Mason Fields responded to the complaint on December 28th, 2021 and met with Ms. Tincher who directed him to the source of the smoke and furnes. Mason inspected the site and found refuse material burning in a hollow directly across the river from Ms. Tincher's home. Research of available documents indicates that the refuse is likely associated with pre-law mining activities performed by Sharlow Gas Coal Company mines 1, 2 and 3 that active in the 1920's.

Due to the scope of the project, the required design, surveying and drilling services to abate the problems at the site will have to be performed by an outside engineering firm. In accordance with Section 5G-1-4 of the State Code of West Virginia, since a special circumstance exists and the cost of the project is estimated to be less than \$250,000.00, I have the option of selecting an architectural/engineering firm on the basis of satisfactory performance and knowledge of the agency's needs. Therefore, I propose to utilize The Thrasher Group of Beckley, WV to perform the required professional services at the site. The estimated cost for these services should not exceed \$50,000.00. The initial estimated cost of the site construction reclamation portion of the project to include mobilization/demobilization, site preparation, excavation and extinguishing of refuse material, regrading and revegetation is approximately \$150,000.00.
