I am requesting an emergency purchase on behalf of our District 2 Headquarters to install a slip liner for a section of pipe that is deteriorating and on the verge of collapse. This pipe is under approximately 150 feet of fill. The pipe is located in Logan at Crawley Creek. If the pipe collapses before the slip liner is installed, DOH will have to bore out the pipe and replace the entire run of pipe. If this happens the cost will exceed 2 Million.

If an emergency is approved, we will need to issue possibly 3 separate purchase orders. The cost of the slip liner is approximately \$113,864.00, the cost for the grout and pump rental is approximately \$28,000 and the cost for the concrete and pump rental is approximately \$25,000. DOH will be coordinating the work to ensure the entire project has been completed.

This pipe is under 150 feet of fill. If the pipe is allowed to collapse it would require a pipe bore which would result in an estimated cost of 2 million dollars. We can prevent the collapse if we can have the approval to purchase and install pipe slip liner with grout. We are looking at an estimated cost of:

- 1. Slip liner = \$113,863.20
- 2. Grout and Pump rental = \$28,000.00
- 3. Concrete and pump rental = \$25,000.00

Due to the weight of the fill, the pipe is collapsing, we are losing our window of opportunity to put in the liners, eventually we will not be able to utilize liners and will have to bore. Please let me know if we can proceed?
