Tara,

WV DOT is requesting permission to proceed with an emergency procurement to replace 1500 feet of the main water line into the I-79 Welcome Center in Morgantown. Currently the Welcome Center has been shut down due to issues with the waterline. The Welcome Center cannot be reopened until the water line has been replaced. I do not have an estimate at this point for the cost of the repairs. District 4 is working to identify plumbers in the area to obtain quotes for the repair. As soon as I am notified of the estimated cost I will pass the information along. I'm sure it will exceed \$25,000 because we will need a plumber to do an emergency repair.
