We have just identified a ruptured high pressure steam line which serves to provide heating to the Main Capitol, Building 3 and Building 4. The inability to maintain the supply of high pressure steam to these facilities will quickly diminish and then eliminate our ability to keep these buildings at a habitable temperature, abruptly impairing the ability for the tenant agencies occupying the buildings to perform their work. We are working to minimize any disruption, but require the services of a HVAC Mechanical Contractor to perform invasive investigation to the get to the root cause of the problem and then rectify it by as prompt a repair as is possible.

Do we have your permission to utilize emergency purchasing procedures to procure these services, which we expect to cost in excess of \$25,000.00?
