Mike:

We have experienced a new leak in the steam distribution system on the Capitol Complex, specifically proximal to Manhole #2 (outside the northern end of the East Wing of the Main Capitol). In our initial exploration of the root cause, we have discovered a ruptured high pressure steam line, plus we believe there are two additional smaller high pressure condensate return lines that are experiencing leaks. Failure to address the matter quickly increases the possibility of catastrophic steam line failure, which could immediately create a significant life/safety concern but would also completely diminish our ability to heat the Main Capitol Building, plus Buildings 3, 4, 5 and 7.

We are requesting permission to proceed, under the regulations for emergency purchasing, to procure the services of a mechanical contractor to immediately come to excavate the subject lines, investigate to determine exact locations of leakage, then

make subsequent repairs to the lines to bring them back into a safe and reliable condition.

Understanding there is an impending holiday, we expect that we will be able to begin work by the late weekend. We anticipate the work will cost approximately \$50K.
