**SUBJECT:** Pipestem McKeever Lodge Emergency Boiler Replacements

We are in immediate need of replacement of four boilers at Pipestem McKeever Lodge. We have only one remaining boiler working. If this remaining boiler fails, we will be forced to close the McKeever lodge and suffer significant revenue losses from not only the Lodge restaurant, lodging, and retail business, but related revenues from golfing and other fee-based activities. The current boiler is being overworked as it is our sole source for heating and hot water in the entire McKeever lodge.

Based on previous work experience and extensive knowledge of the system at Pipestem, we propose that Miller Engineering will be hired as a professional consultant for the project. Professional Services expenses are not expected to exceed \$35,000.00

Construction costs to replace the boilers are not expected to exceed \$400,000.00
