SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR EMERGENCY CONTRACT FOR SECURITY GUARD SERVICES

The West Virginia Department of Transportation urgently requires approval for an Emergency Contract to secure Security Guards at our facility. Our solicitation process commenced in April, and while an award recommendation has been submitted, it is currently pending review by the Purchasing Division without a confirmed timeline for final decision.

The site requiring security houses multiple vehicles, various equipment, and a fuel tank. Due to its rural location, there are no patrol cars or local law enforcement readily available. Therefore, guards are essential to safeguard the on-site assets.

Approaching our \$100,000.00 threshold, it is critical that we establish emergency security coverage without delay. We propose initiating this emergency contract from July 15th to December 31st, given the uncertain duration until a decision is reached. The estimated cost for this 5 ¹/₂-month period is \$130,000.00.
