RE: FY 2017 GRANT AWARDS TO SOLID WASTE AUTHORITIES

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Thirty-two local Solid Waste Authorities (SWAs) will receive grants totaling \$300,000 as a result of action taken by the Solid Waste Management Board (SWMB) at their meeting held in Charleston, WV, on Wednesday, July 20, 2016.

The SWMB Grant Program is designed to assist local SWAs in the job of properly managing solid waste within their perspective counties or regions.

Following are the names of the local SWAs awarded grants, the amounts and designated projects:

Boone County – \$11,500 – for wages, signage and billboard advertising.

Braxton County – \$10,635 – for equipment maintenance and repairs, fuel, insurance, educational conference and a financial examination.

Brooke County - \$9,500 – for insurance and a household hazardous waste event.

Calhoun County - \$12,765 – for wages, insurance and a densifier conveyor belt.

Clay County - \$7,810 – for fuel, advertising, county cleanup and landfill fees.

Greenbrier County - \$6,290 – for sea container and grapple bucket.

Hancock County - \$8,996 - for roll-off charges, processing fees and scrap metal hauling fees.

Harrison County – \$7,000 – for a paint collection event.

Jackson County - \$10,000 - for equipment/vehicle maintenance and wages.

Kanawha County - \$7,500 – for wages and fuel.

Lincoln County - \$13,615 - for county cleanup hauling fees and wages.

Logan County - \$6,000 – for fuel.

Marion County - \$15,000 – for a skid steer loader.

McDowell County - \$11,300 - for a financial exam, educational conference expenses, wages and fuel.

Mercer County - \$9,500 – for Improvements to scale house.

Monongalia County – \$5,950 – for rent, educational conference and a safe and file cabinet.

Monroe County - \$8,000 – for cargo trailers.

Morgan County - \$11,070 – for hauling fees, insurance, utilities, equipment maintenance and repairs and computer software.

Nicholas County - \$6,000 – for pavement of roadway.

Ohio County - \$10,000 – for a household hazardous waste collection event.

Pleasants County - \$11,052 - for educational conference expenses, fuel, insurance and operating supplies.

Pocahontas County - \$12,000 – for a landfill tarp and aerator for leachate pond.

Putnam County - \$8,150 – for educational conference expenses, contractor fees.

Region VIII - \$8,600 – for skid steer attachments.

Roane County - \$14,500 – for educational conference expenses, equipment maintenance, wages and lot paving.

Taylor County - \$3,042 –for insurance and educational conference expenses.

Tucker County - \$9,150 – for purchase and installation of propane generator.

Upshur County - \$8,450 – for insurance, direct mail, office supplies, billboards and field trips.

Wayne County - \$12,228 – for wages, fuel and financial exam.

Wetzel County - \$8,440 – for a portable ramp, cargo trailer, truck tires, recycling supplies and educational conference expenses.

Wood County – \$7,000 –for recycling containers.

Wyoming County – \$8,957 – for tires, wages and a financial exam.
