RE: FY 2018 GRANT AWARDS TO SOLID WASTE AUTHORITIES

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Thirty-six local Solid Waste Authorities (SWAs) will receive grants totaling \$300,000 as a result of action taken by the Solid Waste Management Board (SWMB) at their meeting held in Charleston, WV, on Wednesday, July 19, 2017.

The SWMB Grant Program is designed to assist local SWAs in the job of properly managing solid waste within their perspective counties or regions.

Following are the names of the local SWAs awarded grants, the amounts and designated projects:

Barbour County - \$5,500 - for equipment maintenance and repairs, fuel, insurance and baling wire.

Berkeley County - \$8,200 – for steel storage containers.

Boone County – \$7,250 – for wages and property improvements.

Braxton County – \$9,700 – for equipment maintenance and repairs, fuel, insurance, educational conference, recycling brochures and a financial examination.

Cabell County - \$7,225 – for wages, fuel, electric at gated sites, educational conference and vehicle maintenance and repairs.

Calhoun County - \$9,490 – for wages, insurance and equipment maintenance and repairs.

Clay County - \$8,440 – for contracted services for county cleanup.

Doddridge County - \$1,300 – for a computer and printer.

Fayette County - \$7,500 – for a wench and dump trailer.

Greenbrier County - \$7,500 – for roof replacement.

Hancock County - \$10,000 - for wages and household hazardous waste disposal.

Jackson County - \$6,000 - for wages and fuel.

Jefferson County - \$6,400 – for roll-off containers and vehicle maintenance and repairs.

Kanawha County - \$9,000 – for fuel and forklift and frontend loader repairs.

Lincoln County - \$10,000 - for county cleanup hauling fees and wages.

Marion County - \$9,325 – for wages, financial examination, educational conference, QuickBooks and tools and tool cabinet.

McDowell County - \$4,850 – for educational conference expenses and wages.

Mercer County - \$10,000 – for improvements to scale house.

Mingo County - \$17,000 – for financial examinations.

Monongalia County – \$5,450 – for educational conference, financial examination, printing expenses and utilities.

Monroe County - \$8,500 – for fuel and insurance.

Morgan County - \$9,385 – for wages, hauling fees, insurance, a shredding event, educational conference and computer software.

Ohio County - \$8,750 – for a household hazardous waste collection event.

Pleasants County - \$8,550 - for educational conference expenses, insurance, equipment repairs and financial examinations.

Pocahontas County - \$8,000 – for a curtain for leachate pond.

Preston County - \$16,560 – for financial examinations.

Putnam County - \$7,550 – for educational conference expenses and demolition and testing fees.

Raleigh County - \$12,000 – for replacement of heat/ac ducts and units.

Region VIII - \$10,000 – for paving at the Southern Transfer Station.

Summers County - \$8,550 – for insurance, educational conference and financial examinations.

Taylor County - \$4,650 –for educational conference, insurance and a display board.

Upshur County - \$7,900 – for insurance, direct mail, and educational conference.

Wayne County - \$8,500 – for insurance, wages and tires.

Wetzel County - \$7,400 – for fuel, insurance, recycling supplies, educational conference and safety scaffolding.

Wirt County - \$8,575 – for equipment maintenance and repairs, a loading dock, educational conference and a financial examination.

Wyoming County – \$5,000 – for wages.
