POLICY & PROCEDURE

COLLEGE INTERNSHIPS

Policy: It is the policy of the WV Nursing Home Administrator's Licensing Board (WVNHALB) to consider waiver of the Board's Administrator In Training program consistent with § 3.3.a.2 of the WV Nursing Home Administrator's rule that states: "Possess a baccalaureate degree or higher from a National Association of Long Term Care Administrators (NAB) accredited college program with internship or an accredited college program that has a baccalaureate degree or higher in Health Care Administration, Health Services Administration or a similarly related administration field that includes an internship program. It is the policy of the board to define "an internship program" as it relates to this rule.

Procedure: An internship program shall provide a student and potential licensee candidate with real life work experience organized in an educational and academic manner in a licensed nursing home.

An internship program shall be considered to meet this rule if it meets the following minimum criteria:

a. The program must be completed under the direct supervision of a duly licensed nursing home administrator.

b. The internship must be a minimum of 160 hours of internship training in a nursing home licensed by the state.

c. The internship program must be a formal element of the college program and the internship program must be approved by the WVNHALB.

d. The internship must include a <u>minimum</u> of the following documented areas of study:

- 1. Business Administration
- 2. Nursing 5. Social Services
- 3. Human Resources 6. Activities
- 4. Regulatory Requirements 7. Dietary and Environmental Services

It is incumbent on an applicant for licensure who is requesting a waiver of the AIT program based on these criteria to submit the appropriate supporting information or the waiver cannot be considered by the Board.

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
