## Background

In accordance with §52-1-16 of the West Virginia State Code, circuit clerks provide an annual report of juror qualification questionnaires to the Administrative Office of the Courts. West Virginia Code specifies that the clerk shall make an annual report no later than the first day of March of each year with the following information: whether the clerk employed a jury box or jury wheel for the year reported, and the age, race and gender of each person for whom a juror qualification questionnaire has been received. Under contract with the Division of Criminal Justice Services, the Criminal Justice Statistical Analysis Center enters these questionnaires and generates an annual report for the Administrative Office. The Administrative Office provides this information to the president of the Senate and the speaker of the House of Delegates on an annual basis, no later than the first day of April of each year.

This report summarizes the annual reports received for activity in 2002. The following sections describe the level of reporting; the number of jurors; the gender, race and age of the jurors; and the method used to select jurors.

## Highlights

- All 55 counties submitted an annual report on juror qualification to the Administrative Office.
- A total of 63,266 juror qualification questionnaires were completed. Ohio County reported the largest number of questionnaires at 11,785.
- Males completed 43.6% of the questionnaires and females completed 48.3%.
- Whites completed 65.0% of the questionnaires, blacks completed 1.3%, and other races completed 2.0%. A large percent (31.7%) of the questionnaires did not include race or ethnicity. This prevents conclusive statements to be made about the racial breakdown of the jurors.
- There were more jurors in the 'Over 70' age category than any other age category. Most other age categories spanned only five ages. This suggests that the age categories on the annual reports should be revised to span an equal number of ages.
- 61.8% of the counties used the jury wheel to select jurors, 12.7% used the jury box, and 9.1% used a computer. 16.4%, or 9 counties, did not report their method.

# Results

## Counties Reporting

All fifty-five counties submitted juror qualification reports for activity between January 1 and December 31, 2002.

## Total Jurors Qualified

A total of 63,266 individuals (3.5% of the state population) completed a juror qualification questionnaire in 2002. This represents an increase of 5.8% over 2001. The number of individuals completing the questionnaire ranged from a low of 95 in Doddridge County to a high of 11,785 in Ohio County. Ohio County also reported the highest number of questionnaires in 2001 (11,275), as well as in 2000 (10,920).

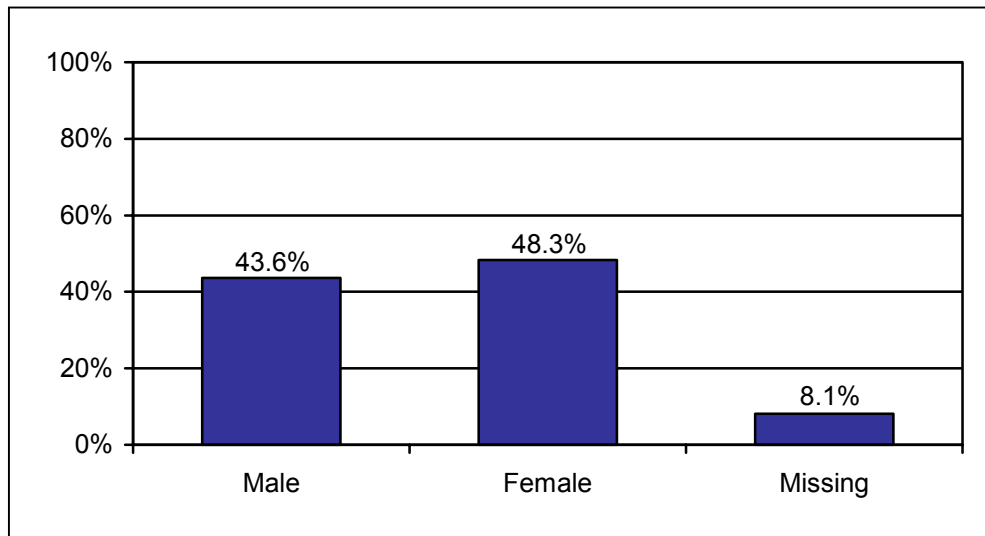

## Gender

Of the 63,266 jurors who completed a juror qualification questionnaire in 2002, 27,573 were males (43.6%) and 30,559 were females (48.3%). The gender was not reported on 5,134 questionnaires (8.1%). When the missing information was excluded, 47.4% were males and 52.6% were females.

## Race/Ethnicity

Of the 63,266 jurors who completed a juror qualification questionnaire, 41,148 (65.0%) reported their race as white. There were 815 black jurors (1.3%), 136 Asian jurors (0.2%), and 12 Native American jurors (0.02%). A small percent (1.5%), or 926 jurors, were reported as "Other." According to the U.S. Census Bureau, 95.0% of the West Virginia population were white, 3.2% were black, 0.2% were American Indian or Alaska Native, 0.5% were Asian, 0.2% were some other race, and 0.9% reported two or more races in 2000.

The U.S. Census Bureau considers Hispanic and Latino as ethnic origins within the existing races. In 2000, 0.7% of the state population was of Hispanic or Latino origin. 165 jurors (0.3%) selected Hispanic as their race in 2002.

Racial information was not provided for 20,064 jurors (31.7%). This continues to be substantially higher than in years prior to 2000. Given the large amount of missing information, caution should be taken when interpreting these percents.

*Graph 2: Percent of Jurors and Population by Race/Ethnicity*

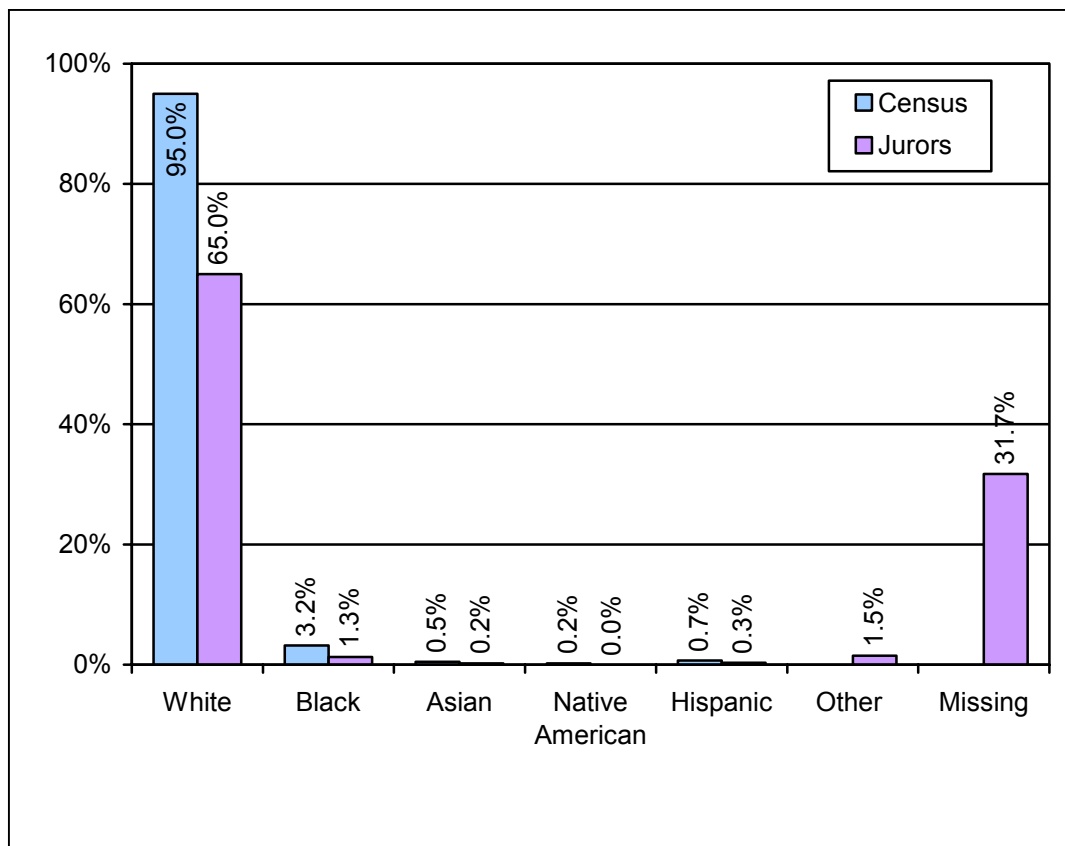

## Age

The number of individuals in each age increment ranged from a high of 8,020 individuals (12.7%) in the 'Over 70' category to a low of 3,135 individuals (5.0%) in the '66-70' category. The 'Over 70' category and the '18-25' category each span more than five years and, consequently, both have a relatively large number of jurors. New categories could be developed that span an equal number of years per category, such as 18-22, 23-27, etc. Additionally, given the large percent in the 'Over 70' category, this could be broken into smaller age groups. The age was missing or unknown for 2,226 individuals (3.5%).

*Graph 3: Percent of Jurors by Age Category*

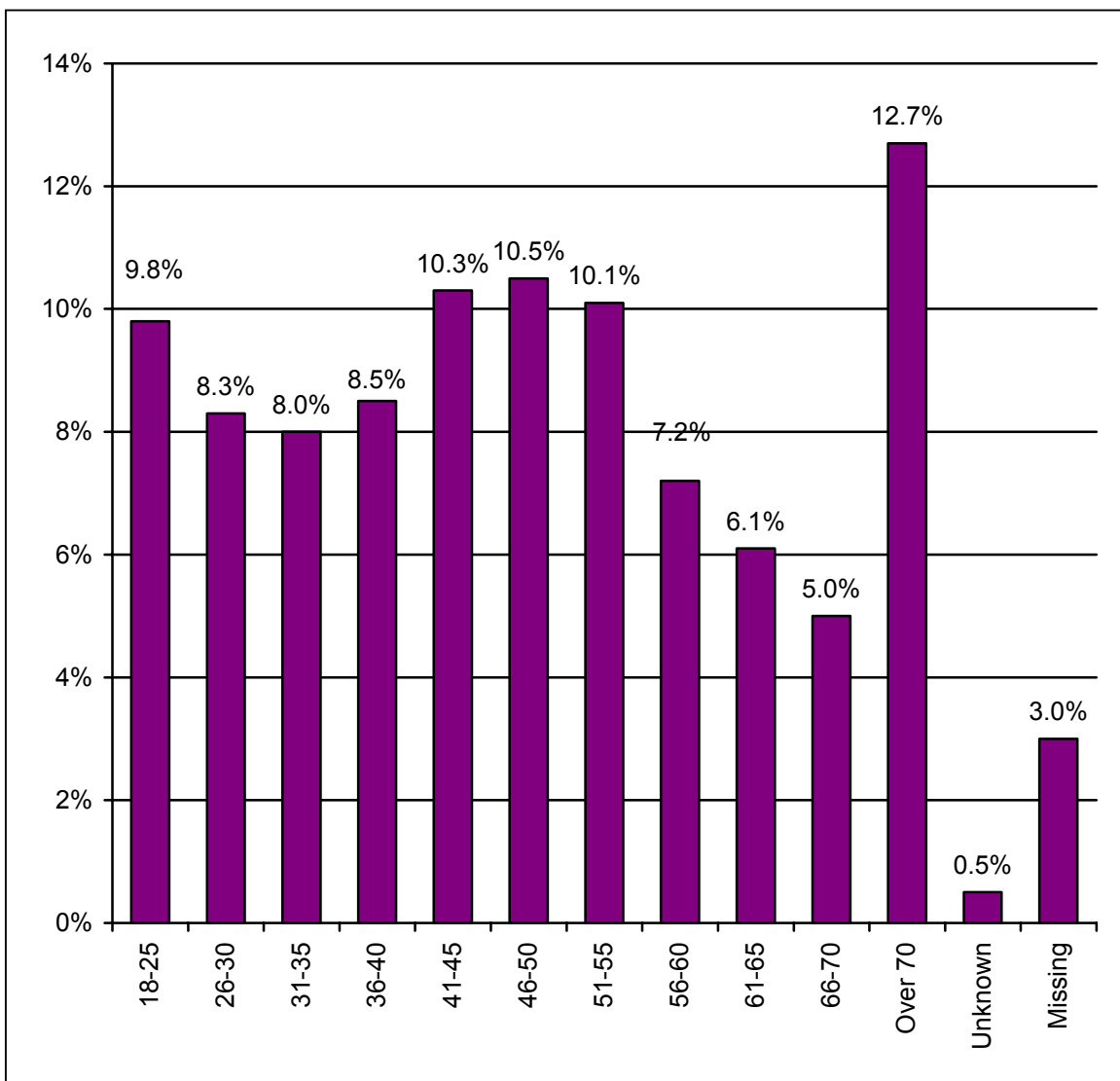

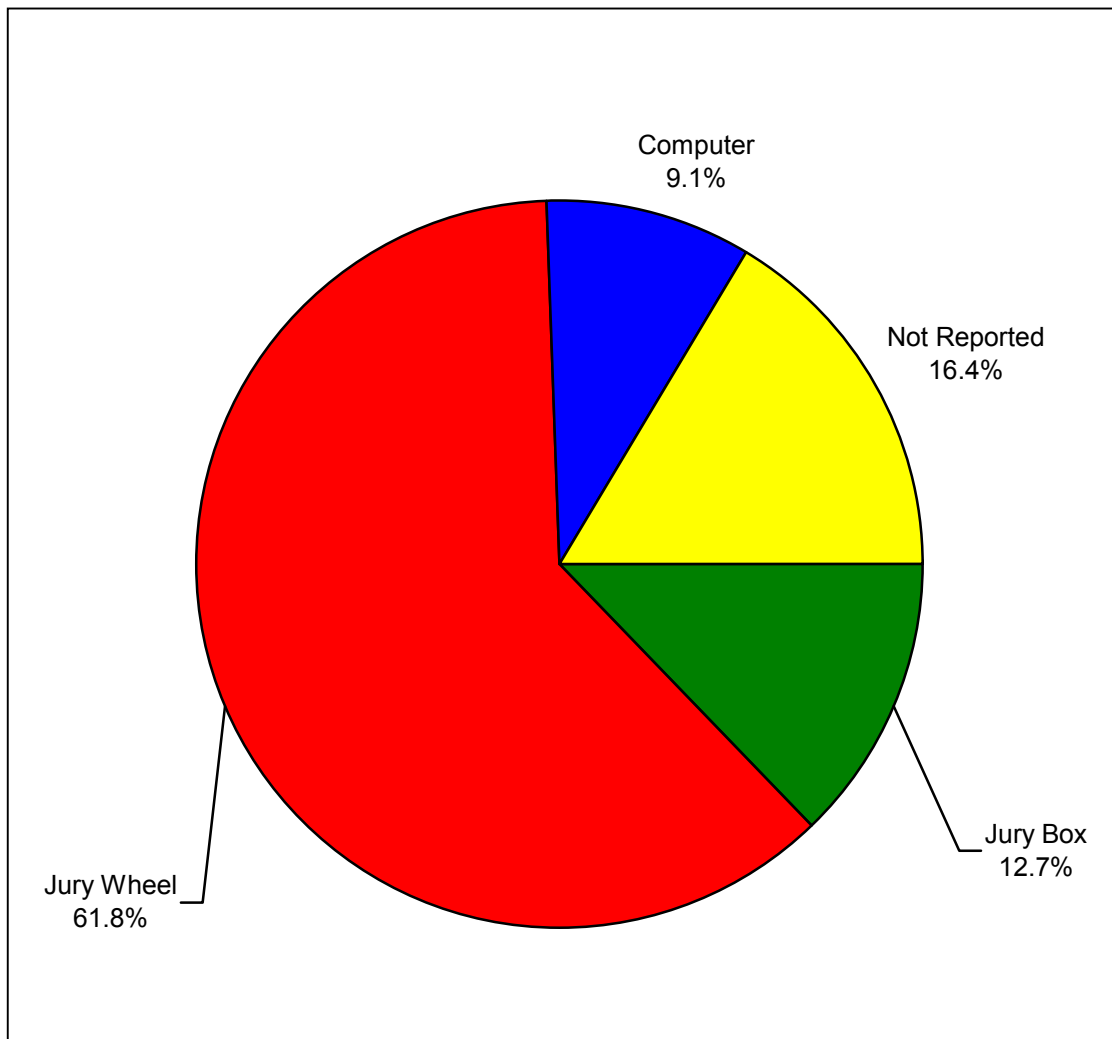

### Jury Selection Method

In 2002, thirty-four counties (61.8%) used the jury wheel and seven counties (12.7%) used the jury box to select potential jurors. Computers were used in five counties (9.1%).

Nine counties (16.4%) did not provide information on the method used. Given the amount of missing information, caution should be taken when interpreting these percents.
