At a Regular Term of the Supreme Court of Appeals continued and held at Charleston, Kanawha County, on the 12th day of May, 2010, the following order was made and entered:

RE: REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE

On a former day, to-wit, May 3, 2010, came the Clerk of Court and formally presented to the Court the final draft of proposed comprehensive revisions to the RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE that have been considered for internal review and comment by the Court and its staff for several months. Upon careful deliberation, the Court is of the opinion that the proposed revisions should be placed for public comment.

It is therefore ordered that the Clerk shall prepare the rules to be published for comment and release the proposed REVISED RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE on Monday, May 17, 2010, for a period of public comment to conclude on **July 19, 2010**, with public comments to be filed with the Clerk of Court. The Clerk's Comments contained in the proposed revisions are provided only to assist the reader and do not constitute a substantive component of the rules.

The Clerk of Court is directed to provide copies of the proposed revisions to all circuit judges, family court judges, circuit clerks, and official court reporters in the State.
