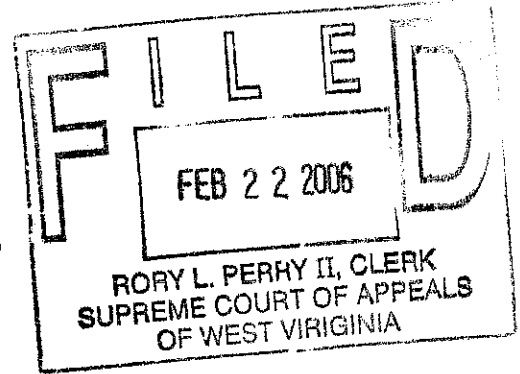

Wayne King discussed the former complaint with Mr. Boggs at the time of the preparation and execution of the note and Mr. Boggs was fully aware of the requirements, however since this was a transaction between relatives, all of the parties were very comfortable and satisfied with the arrangements.


Wayne King hereby states that he stands by the statements given to bar counsel in writing and at any interview.

Please accept this statement as my Answer to the charges in this complaint.





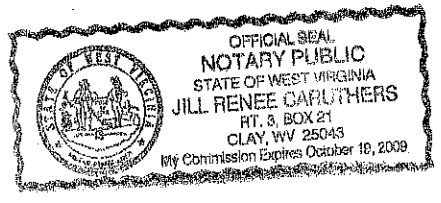
