RE: **UNI Rate Increase - effective October 1, 2023 (FY2024)**

This memo is to notify you of an increase in the fee for using AAMVA's Unified Network Interface (UNI), effective October 1, 2023 (FY2024). UNI is an AAMVA service that handles message exchanges between two or more AAMVAnet sites. It was developed and paid for by AAMVA member agencies and jurisdictions continue to rely on this software and pay for its use in the form of a license charge calculated to recover the cost of maintaining the service.

AAMVA conducts regular reviews of our IT services to assess them for member value and reliability among other factors. In our most recent review, we identified UNI for certain modifications, among them retiring the legacy version of this service. UNI is offered in two formats, UNI Mainframe (aka UNI Legacy) and UNI Windows. With advances in technology and alternative network connections, AAMVA is proceeding with its plans to sunset UNI Legacy in 2025.

Following the system review, AAMVA staff recommended to the AAMVA Board of Directors (Board) a plan to better recover the costs of continuing to offer UNI Legacy through 2024 and operating and enhancing UNI Windows into the foreseeable future.

Before approving the fee increase, the Board considered the following factors:

- UNI fees (Legacy and Windows) were last increased in 2008 and do not recover program costs
- Increased support costs in UNI Windows are expected as agencies choose UNI Windows for secure network connections past January 2025.

In addition, the AAMVA Board considered several options staff proposed that would incrementally achieve cost recovery. The agreed upon approach increases the annual cost of UNI Legacy by about \$5,000 in each of the next several years and UNI Windows about \$2,000 in each of the next several years starting on October 1, 2023, as communicated in last year's memo dated October 1, 2021.

Both fee changes take effect October 1, 2022 (FY2023) and increase again on October 1, 2023 (FY2024) as shown in the following table:

This fee increase may impact contracts and purchase orders you have in place with AAMVA or others. We are informing you a year in advance to be sure you have time to account for the change while planning for budgeting, contract renewals, or other related activities that enable your UNI use.

While the estimated cost recovery strategy anticipates the above-described future year increases, the Board will review the program budget each year and we will notify you a year in advance of any changes beyond FY2024. In addition, AAMVA is developing new interfaces to its IT systems that will allow jurisdictions to connect directly without the need of the UNI software. These new interfaces will provide jurisdictions the opportunity to select the best technical option that meets their needs.

RE: **Notification of FY2024 NMVTIS State User Fees and FY2024 Fee Table**

In support of state budget planning cycles and in accordance with federal regulations governing the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS), I am sending this memo to notify you twelve months in advance of FY2024 NMVTIS State User Fees which will apply October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024 (see fee table, Attachment 1).

Overall FY2024 NMVTIS State User Fees have been set at \$9,886,610, and the key tenets include:

- State User Fees cover all operations and maintenance (O&M) expenses. This is a change from prior years as explained below.
- The State User Fee allocation is based on the vehicle registration population as published by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).
- State User Fees are allocated using a progressive six tier structure (see Table 1).
- States approved by the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) as in compliance with NMVTIS will receive a 50% credit of the revenue collected for each consumer access transaction where data is returned for a VIN pointing to that state as the current state of title. At its meeting this month, the AAMVA Board of Directors voted to increase this FY2024 credit percentage, known as the Jurisdiction Revenue Share (JRS), from 47% in FY2023 to 50% in FY2024.
- The NMVTIS Consumer Access State Fee Credit reminder memo will be sent out shortly along with DOJ's notice regarding eligible uses for the credits.

AAMVA recognizes that FY2024 NMVTIS State User Fees are a significant increase over FY2023. As discussed in the May 23, 2022 memo (Attachment 2), the federal Anti Car Theft Act and the current NMVTIS Cooperative Agreement between AAMVA and DOJ, require NMVTIS to be self-funded through user fees, and not rely upon federal or other funds such as AAMVA reserves. The higher amount to be funded by states in FY2024 and later includes funding for all O&M expenses which had previously been offset by AAMVA's share of Consumer Access Program (CAP) revenue.

Going forward, CAP revenue will be used to fund system improvements, JRS, and operating reserves. Eligible states will continue to be able to apply their credits to offset their annual NMVTIS state fees. This approach will ensure the long-term financial and operational sustainability of NMVTIS.

As part of AAMVA’s continuing effort to provide equitable cost sharing among parties, we are working with the Federal Highway Administration to review the methodology they use to calculate the state motor vehicle registration statistics. Additionally, AAMVA is committed to working with our partners to explore opportunities to generate new revenue for NMVTIS that could be used to offset state fees.

Please see attachment regarding price increases. The vendor sent us the memos last September advising us that there would be a price increase effective 10/1/23. The attachment explains it, but thought this breakdown would make more sense.

CDLIS Fee (.0275) - didn't change

AAMVA Program Service Fee - went down from \$2,229.957 to \$2,210.91

AAMVA Technology Fee - went down from \$963.44 to \$955.22

SSN Verification - didn't change

AAMVA Net Service Fee - didn't change

UNI Windows Maintenance Fee - went up from \$1,034.54 to \$1,206.24 (based on attached letter dated 9/30/22)
