Mike, we lost a section of dryvit (EIFS) exterior wall panel at Bldg. 36 on Friday. We've been trying to get something done but it looks like we'll be over the agency's \$25K limit. As you can see from the photo, we have exposed our interior electrical and walls to the elements. We need a more permanent solution as quickly as possible before any more heavy winds or rain gets in the building. Right now the winds are slowly pulling the remainder of the insulation out allowing the elements to bear directly on the interior walls between the windows. Because of the location and height, it is out of our reach for normal work from our folks. Let me know what you think. Bill

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
